Espira Feb 2, th 1888

I was a cloudy morning with
a strong south wind.

Herman arrived in Espira all
right and found verrey thing
in good order

This morning it was
cloudy. We butchered a
young cow. Gomez was
here. Herman and Gomez
went up to Torieu to see
the capata who is sick
Herman had a bath in the
afternoon ^{Hoise} ^{Wagner} ~~no~~ ^{Wagner} ~~Wagner~~ came here
on his way up to Torieu place

4

This morning it was fine weather.
Herman and poen went along
the coast of the Espira river

down to the martello. Picho recored
the camp on the west side of the river.
This afternoon John came here.

George Wagerer called on here on his
way back his carts up set in the
canada they were loaded with hides.
A Courtis came here to stay the night.
Dona Fidosa and her sister went
up to Torres on a visit.

5

This morning it was fine weather
it warm. Courtis was here and also
Palmero and Tiburno.

This afternoon Caspar and all
the Souzger were here.

There saw two races run at the
pulpes. Wastasar and
another Indian came here to see
Lerman.

Feb 6. 1888

This morning it was fine weather.
We put the cattle on roads on the
east side. So Herman could see
the rivillon two of Trieres poem
came and helped cure 4 calves.

This afternoon we cleaned the well
it had clots of muck.

Herman wrote to Alfred today
Old John was here today.

7.

This morning it warm with a
north wind. The Gues from Sant
Martin was here. Ofold from
Mablaligo was here with another
man. They brought in a letter
from Roman. Landino cut
wood in the morning.

This afternoon Felix and
Havito another man were here.

Feb 8 1888

This morning it was warm.

We put the cattle on roads and cured 10 calves and 10 big animals. The Sues came here and stayed here.

This afternoon Angel was here, the Sakel was here the Sues left in the evening.

9

This morning Picho and Candelio went to see the marsh.

This afternoon no body came.

10

This morning the Gamages were here.

Herman went over today.

The capataz from
Don Papervirocoro
was here Percio and
Mareales came

This afternoon Harro^{nto} came
and went away again:

11

This morning it was warm
and Sunday we butchered an
old cow. It rained a little in the
forenoon. This afternoon all of
Torres' poems came and lasted
all night long.

12

This morning early the
capataz got sick with rage
but got better afterwards.
Richard Morgen came
to see me. ~~From~~ Sissino
Gomez had breakfast

with us. This afternoon their were
races. And all the Samezo were
here and also. Sagen capatar was
here with another man and two women
kinlar was here.

13

This morning we put the
cattle on roads cart rid and cured
two bulls ^{and} calves and captured
several of Indians bulls.

This afternoon Picho and
Candilio went to fix the fence
where the Indian had cut

14

This morning it was fine weather
Picho went up to Torieres to see
the capatar. Chindo went over
to the English place and brought
over our mare and potato
Candilio cut wood in the morote

Feb. 15 1888.

This morning it fine weather. Candilio went up to Torres place to get the cart. Picho went to campar some mares and found them in the monte. This afternoon sent cart to the monte to get wood. Herman cut corn for the horses in the corral. Baldomero came this evening to ask us to help put on roaders to morrow.

16

This morning it warm. Picho and Candilio went up to Torres place and helped put cattle on roaders and part out novillos for the

irivarado. This afternoon nobody
came.

17

This morning it was cloudy
We put the cattle on roads
and cured 10 big animals
and 5 calves. We butchered an old cow
This afternoon we salted
the meat. Maria Loro came back
this evening. Sakel and Lorenie
is cutting jagas here.

18

This morning it was cloudy
We pulled a bull claf out of a
well at the tapura on the road
sent the cart for wood.
Herman went to the old span
and recorded the Espin river
This afternoon Baldemero came
Valentin's carts were here
sent Candilio \$2.00 and others \$1.00

Feb 19 1888

This morning it rained
a little. There were races
at the pulperie. Pickon
has won the race with the
Sonearario. Richard Morgan
was here. The Gomezes were
here this afternoon.

20.

This morning it rained
a good shower. Trimmilars
wife left him. And went
down to Sant. Justo.

This afternoon it cleared up.
there were several boatmen
here.

21

This morning it was cloudy.
Herman went to visit Gomez
and stoped all day long.

This afternoon Herman came
back from Sonnes place and
found several other Corvintinos
here. This evening it was thundering
, 22, (but did not rain)

This morning it was fine
weather. Richard Morgan
came and stayed all day
long. This afternoon Herman
sent several Corvintinos away
from the place.

, 23.
This morning it was windy
clear weather. Stage brought
Herman a letter from Alfred.
Richard Morgan is here
still. This afternoon Sonnes
came and Richard Morgan
left.

Feb. 24. 1888.

This morning it was fine weather it was very warm

Nobody came and we sent Baudelino to look after the man

25.

This morning it was so hot that we could not work or do nothing. Herman went over to John's place.

We butchered an old cow.

26.

This morning it was fine weather and plenty of people here. There were races and the Gomezes were here to dinner.

Feb ^{the} 27. 1888

This morning it was fine weather
Herman agreed a count with
Trimaler we owe him 170\$40
cents. Herman wrote to Alfred
answering his letter and sent
him the account.

This afternoon nobody came.
28.

This morning it fine
weather. Herman cut Alfa.

Old John came.

This afternoon Picho and
bandilino and Jose Chino and
all Torrem poem went to
part out at Don Augustin

Old John went also

Herman stoped at home
and cut Alfa and came
for the horse at night

Feb. 29, 1888.

This morning it was fine weather and very warm.

Gaspar Durran came and stoped the day here he barrowed 15 [¢] from Herman.

This afternoon it got cloudy and looks stormy.

Gaspar left in the evening.

March 1, 1888.

This morning it was fresh and a strong south wind Gomez and Amando Liva were here to dinner break. This afternoon the people from the aparta came back. We marked 7 calves and one cow. We also captured 4 bulls. One of the bulls spiked Candilio badly.

Baldemero came here this evening late

2.

This morning it was cloudy and a north wind. We butchered an old cow. from the aparte.

Ritchard Morgan came here to see about the paga.

He stoped here to dinner.

Sandilis is a little better to day.

This afternoon two Cornutus came here. Ritchard left in the evening. Baldemero came here. Herman brought up all the dry Alfa that was cut.

3.

This morning it was fine weather. Acharkey came from Gomez came and asked Herman go with them on an expedition. The Indians stole 20 more

Torres capata and several from
And Hernan and Jose Chino went
we all accompanied Torres the
first night we slept at the
Margarita.

4

This morning we marched
as far as the rancho there
was no water for the horses.

So we came back to the
Margarita. Juven Gomez very
sick. Torres capata left
a horse behind.

6

This morning We arrived
in Espin. Hernan stopped
at Sanzen to rest old papa
left directly at Margarita
This afternoon Hernan arrived.

March 7. 1858

This morning we put the cattle
on rodos and capared 4 bulls.

Mister Fox was here he called
on here on his way to the condor
of it rained half the night

This morning it cleared up
and was a fine day. The galls
did not come to day

This afternoon Cardilino
made mind to revoke the
house. The Gomezes were here
with the capataz ^{of the} and the
carrevario and Megal Duran
were here.

9

This morning it was fine weather
We put the cattle on rodos on
the west side and cured Calves
and capared 8 bulls.

We butchered an old cow
In the afternoon we garbared
the meat.

10

This morning it was
fine weather we brought up
all our mares and started
out all the readmorn and
pobos.

This afternoon it rained
a little

11

This morning it was cloudy
The commissaries brought 8 @
potatoes which Heriman
prayed to certify the @.

Heriman wrote to mother
and also to Josephine.

March th 12 1858

This morning it was cloudy
the stage came and brought
a letter from Johnie and several
packages of news papers
several carts loaded with
people passed here on their
way to the cobudo.

A North American man
came here to hunt.

This afternoon it rained
13

This morning it got
cleared up and got cloudy
again and rained a little

William went to hunt
but got lost in the woods

This afternoon Picho
came back from the cobudo

William came back also from
hunting got nothing

March 14, 1858

This ~~morning~~ ^{morning} we put
the cattle on roads on the west
side and cured several big
animals and 4 calves and also
capped 12 bulls.

This afternoon we fixed
the axle of the cart.

Jose went to Papio Blas
William went as far as a
Angel to hunt tomorrow
with angel

Margarita is stopping here.

15

This morning it was fine
weather. And was a very hot day
Picho and Marroles and rekal
and Lorego gathered corn they
gathered half the field.
Hermann received a letter from

Alfred. This afternoon we halled
the corn home.

Megal Duran came here on his
way to the Cochinos and told us
that Berley got murdered and
all his stock.

16

This morning it was fine
weather. We put the cattle on
rodos on the east side, and cured
4 calves and castrated 8 bulls

And butchered an old cow

All of Ferreres people came
with a troop of potros and
mules, shut them in our corral
and commenced to domarising the
potros.

This afternoon they left
here. In the evening 3 men came
and stayed here the night.

March 17. 1888

This morning it was fine weather.
We did nothing the holiday
long. No body came here.
18

This morning it was fine
weather. There was a lot of
people here. Tomas and Caspar
Loran and Savino Tomas
and several other men were
here to dinner.
19

This morning it was
cloudy but did not rain.
Herman wrote to Alfred
This afternoon Picho
came back late from the
Cahudo and all so brought
Avillenor muros with him
Picho brought a letter for

Herman from the Comararia
Kenar. some Comarino people left
here

20.

This morning it was fine
weather. Herman went to visit
the Gomeri and also took a
letter to them.

This afternoon Herman
came home late in the evening.

21

This morning it was fine
weather. Nobody came here.
This afternoon a man
came from largein.
Herman went to the
Cohodor to see the Comarari
about the Butchering of four
cattle down there.
Herman stayed there two
whole days.

Marchth 22 1884

This morning it was
fine weather. The stage
brought two packets
of news papers.

23

This morning it was
fine weather. Pichs Butchered
an old cow had the cattle
over rods and cured several
animals and cut several
bulls. A cow died from rage.

24

This morning it was cloudy
Herman came home
with another Estanero
who is going up north
it commenced to rain in
torrents and lasted all day
long.

March th 25. 1888.

This morning it was fine weather. There were lots of people here. And races were run.

This afternoon it got cloudy it rained in the evening.

.26

This morning it cleared up. Angel came and gave Herman notice of a skull being found at the saladillo pass. Herman wrote home.

This afternoon no body came here.

.27.

This morning it was fine weather. Herman took Mardeno and went to look for the rest of the bones at the pass.

March 28 1888

This morning it was fine weather. Herman and Bontuto went fishing at the toba and stayed all day long.

This afternoon Herman and Bontuto came home and brought one fish home. Candilio went to Palabrigo yesterday to get a papetetas.

29

This morning it was fine weather. Candilio came back, no body came here.

30

This morning it was fine weather, all our people went to the valoris at the morio of Torruca.

March 31. 1888

This morning it was fine weather. The poens came back from the valorio. banditio stayed there. ~~No~~ No body came here this afternoon

April 1. 1888.

This morning it was fine weather. lots of people here Angel wanted to shoot his wife. No body came here.

2

This morning it was fine weather. We gave roderos to Corrier they came and parted out 30 animals. We butchered an old cow. ^(east roderos)
