

Oct 2/88.

Had the rodeo on and parted all Walker's cattle out about 133 making about 315 out in pastures. Walker hired two men and the rest were gone from here. Pleasant day but looks like more rain. Rich Morgan stops the night.

- 3 -

Had middle rodeo on and parted all of Walker's cattle out 164. Fine day for working. Same gents as yesterday. rather slow work. Antonio Lara was here, also Rich Morgan stops. The Tropeiro Juan Young stops the night on way to Languira.

- 4 -

Put west rodeo and finished parting Walker's cattle thank god! parted about 96. Butchered one fat cow of Walker. Antonio Lara was here all day. Rich Morgan left. It was a very fresh day. Same gents as yesterday worked except Walker had one yunta more.

Oct 5/88

Some of Walters cattle got out of corral last night; delivered the ~~stock~~ 528 to the Brasilero, and 26 yeguarzo among which were 6 horses. Also received the mares and redomons of Donkins from Walker ~~45~~ ¹⁴ mares and 9 redomons.

There are yet of Donkins, 1 yegua parrada at Wests. 1 ^{rosillo} mare at vuida Jallis, 1 redomon Jack Heart has and 1 Joe Moore has yet. Went to Torres to see about rodeo at Zapatas next week. Foggy morning but pleasant day. Tremolieri rec'd \$800.00 from Johnnie to pay our debt at pulperia. Put Donkins manada in monte.

- 6 -

Walters and McLean went for a pass up to Fox encampment at Margarita. Brought a load of wood. Stefons caught some of our mares in Torres camp. Nothing going on. Fine day.

Oct 7/88

Sunday. Nothing going on. Walter Anseau
came back from Picado. Stormy evening fine day.
Ramesyer stops night waiting for rodeo.

— 8 —

Put all catth from west side on rodeo and
parted 31 of Walters catth that had escaped from
corral the other night. Also sold to Ramesyer
2 fat ~~over~~ [#]13.00 on credit and also to Wassie
1 cow at 12.00 and 2 novillos at \$15.00 on credit.
Also sold 1 novillo to Pases Manuel — at
\$15.00 cash and gave him 6 novillos to tame
for 18 months. He took 2 osko overos. 1 novillo
1 novillo overo. 1 colorado. 1 chariado. Antonio
Lara and Gabriel ~~Tran~~ ^{Tran} were here.
Had a heavy storm last night but little rain.
misty day. —

— 9 —

Put catth from east side on rodeo and parted
the rest of Walters catth (9) out. Big bull gave

lot of trouble. This afternoon Alfonso Benabe and Baldomero went with Walkers pastored (38) to Zapatas where there is sodeo tomorrow. Alfred and Robson Walkers with went to priests to see and receive Donkins things. Rec'd 30 horse 2 madrinas, 1 colundo 2 patranecas. 1 olla tres patas. 1 brasera, 1 romana, 1 saw, 1 meat chopper 1 slot gun. 3 ps. juguillas 4 balanzas 1 montura 1 piqueta (part, ^{here} medicine chest, clock, diary.

Alfred bought Walkers chucheria over there for \$20.00 viz:— 2 round spades 2 flat spades 2 shovels 2 axes 1 1/2 inch auger 1 adze 1 caserolo 1 sarten 1 olla 3 pans 70 lbs alfa seed washbasin 4 tin cups, box, coffee machine. It was a very pleasant day. Bot Walkers watch \$5.00.

Went up to Zapatas to past but found nothing in their sodeo. took Walkers cattle to Lewis' gate and entregared them

Oct/88

t. Antonio Lara. 41, making 567 altogether.
Juan Gomez locked in with 150 pesos from
Sarguindo and Luis my fat. Encargued
Juan Gomez to sell 2 novillas of ours at Turraspe
last last year. It was a very pleasant day.
Butchered an old cow 11

Thomas started cross plowing for alfa. Walker
left for down to Rosario with galera; bought
nearly every thing he had left viz rifle 10.00
table 5.00 - grindstone 2.00 watch 5.00 100 cartridges
17 hides for \$46.92 3 reses we had butchered cured ovette
24.00 and arranged for 11 months rent 530.00
He gave me an order on Luis to balance account
\$521.00 which he sends up to me from Sta Fe
as soon as he can. Gave Stefano an order on
Don Hipolito for \$24.00 to pay his debt there.
It was a pleasant day.

Oct 18/88.

Alfred had gone to Reconquista on the 13th
and came back by Malabrigo on the 16th. Rather
an unlucky trip as he lost the two black dogs in
Reconquista and the two bombillas the plate which
he was taking to have mended and a painting that
McLean sent to Mrs Fuller. Spent Robson \$5.00. Alex Leira
loan 5.00 Reproceso for finding horses which got lost from
fonda 3.00 Hamans' bill at Fuller 28.00 Goods by auction
Robson 3.00 knife 3.00 dress for Dona Leidora 4.50 10.50
Ramayon old age of money he had paid out 56.00. Hotel
in Reconq. 2.60. Hotel in Malabrigo 2.60 Patricia 2.00
Etc 6.00. alt Butcherd a cow on the 14th. Defores
ported at Gomez on the 15th. 7 or 8 animals. made
Gomez counter mark a fine calf which afterwards died.
Haas(?) and Fankhauser had been here had seen
the painting and bombillas on road but left them
covered up (rather queer!) The butcher from the
terraplen came yesterday and today paraded
rodeo and sold him 19 mullas (1 of \$⁷) and

5 cows at \$12.50. He is to pay \$15.00 for the maddles soon but if he comes again and takes 50 altogether, gets them at \$14.00. Hot weather and looks as if we are going to have a storm.

- 19 -

Thomas finished cross plowing and began harrowing. Poisoned the hides; Humans dog brea negro also got poisoned. Had a sharp hail storm this afternoon and rained a good deal and looks stormy yet. Alfonso campared some maws unsuccessfully.

- 20 -

Rained some more last night and this morning it was pretty misty. Butchered an old cow this afternoon. Nothing going on. Jaribaldi fixed take over.

- 21 -

Sunday. Nothing going on. Alfred revisaed monte and reconado. Mr. Scott and Doming's Chico stop the night on way from Reconquista to Saufuste. The Gmeys were here to day. Murky day and looks like more rain. Espin swimming.

Oct 22/88. —

Rained nearly all night and drizzled good deal today. *Coronilla* the *Pampita* was taken by the *Comisario* today. Nothing going on.

- 23 -

Cleared up into a fine day. Captured 5 *chudras* of *Donkino's* *manada* and 1 of ours by *Perico*. *Alfred* was up to see *Carabaca*. Nothing going on.

- 24 -

Stefano's & *Tomás* & boys brought a big *mestizo* bull out of *Lomas* *invernada*. *Reverend* part of house. *Alfred* was out side by *new station* etc. It was a pleasant day but looks stormy.

- 25 -

Mail day. Still no news from *Stevens* nor from *Walker*. *Budchud* a fat cow. Poisoned hides. It was a warm day.

- 26 -

Had a heavy storm last night and rained a good deal. Recovered camp this afternoon. 2 Swiss from *Poludras* to *Malabrigo's* stop the night.

Oct 27/88

Brought two bulls in from Torres camp and also pulled fence up a bit. Tomas harrowed the land which is still very wet. Nothing going on. Hot close weather and looks rainy. —

- 28 -

Sunday. Rained nearly all last night and some today also. Cleared up towards evening. McLean went across Taba which is very high to Morgan's place. Gonzales Tremollice sent to visit the indian horses at puisti. ~~McLean~~ brought ~~two~~ ^{one} mare and a puma from Torres camp. —

- 29 -

Alejo was up at Gomez and Tremollice's. Received a letter from Stearns saying he had ^{not} received answer from England yet about the camp. It was a warm day. McLean came back from Morgan's. McLean sowed alfa seed in field and Tomas harrowed it in.

Oct 30/88

It was a misty forenoon and a hot afternoon.
About 100 mestizo bulls for Torres passed from
Buenos Ayres by way of Sunchales about 13 had died.

- 31 -

Rained again hard towards morning and it was
a hot close afternoon. Bound to have more rain.

The men that are going to take the traps of novillos
home are here, but can't part on account of wet weather.
Butchered an old cow (hide for lasso.)

Nov 1/

Reopened camp today. Mail day.

- 2 -

Began parting the novillada today. This morning
parted about 127 of the north side of west sideo
and this afternoon parted about 83 of the east sideo.
Penco (capataz) Marcelino & companions, ^{and Tomas} Juan Moreira,
and the subis — worked with their own horses.
Pichis, Alfonso, Patricio, and Tomas (from our neighbor)
helped. It was a hot day very close, and drizzled
some. Sold a fat cow to Manuel the Baseo Cash \$13.00

Nov. 3/88

Put cattle of south ^{west} on rodeo and parted 99 novillos
and 5 fat calves to butcher on the road. Same
gente as yesterday worked. afterwards helped
the tropa across the arroya at puerto and counted
them 299 ^(see Nov 6) of which are 5 of Lonkins, 18 Tegathens,
and 5 calves to butcher. Badly counted and afraid
go tomorrow to accompany them on road, and
will recount. Same gente as worked with their
horses yesterday and Patricio ^{7 altogether} go with troop. Perico
brought the visti-bueno for tropa from Comisario.
It was a very hot close day. Cattle gave a lot
of work at the arroya and 3 escaped there.

Afraid had gone to see the tropa off as far
as the Naton on the 4th and came back today.
Counted them at the Naton there were 299 or 300
novillos and 4 calves to butcher (one had been butchered
at Irondos enmada) Gave Perico \$25.00 for gastos
and orders to get them by the 15th. Go by way of
Santa Fe! Rained nearly the whole time for last

3 days. Sifonso butchered a cow yesterday.
Nothing going on. - 7 -

One of the peones of the tropa (Buille) came
back from Suebrachos. so only six go. expenses
of tropa ought to be \$228. or 76¢ per head. Recorred
camp and cleared up place. Looks like clearing
up at last. Pleasant day. -

- 8 -

Put catch of ^{note} west side on sodas and disembarked
50 or 70 calves. Received letter from Stevens saying
board declines my proposition to take 9 leagues
of camp and fence it. Eulalia missing tonight.
guess cleared off with Bernabe or Saldomero. It
was a pleasant day. -

- 9 -

Put middle catch on sodas and cured about 40
calves. No news of Eulalia; cleared Bernabe off
place. It was a hot day.

Nov. 10. / 88

Alfredo was up at Carabacas. Nothing going on.
Baldomero brought Eulalia back. But stormy day.

- 11 -

Sunday. Began raining about day break and rained until nearly noon. Butchered a vaquilla as meat wout last. Alfredo got peared his foot against a post in the laguna while bathing, and got it pasmared; had to go to bed about it.

- 12 -

Put cattle of east side on rodeo and lisen-
-becharred about 20 calves and some big animals
and capared some ugly bulls. Alfredo very bad
with foot. McLean came back from picada. Very
fresh weather with strong wind.

- 13 -

Alfredo still laid up with bad foot. Robson,
Lluis and Puello pursued the mares in
-rinconado; none imbecharred. Rained some
today.

West. 14/88

Had a sharp rain again last night. Alfred still laid up with bad foot. Nothing going on except recurring camp. Got rubber lona back stolen by Juan some months ago. Cool day.

- 15 -

Cool day. Nothing going on. Alfred still laid up.

- 16 -

Had west rodeo on and cured 30 or 40 calves. and castrated some bulls. Nothing going on. Butchered old cow.

- 17 -

Had middle rodeo on and cured a few calves and castrated 4 calves and castrated about a dozen bulls. Recurred camp, etc. Cool nights and pleasant days. Alfred still laid up with bad foot.

- 18 -

Sunday, J. Truett, Antonio Lara, and the Gomez were here this afternoon. Pleasant day nothing going on. Alfred making preparations to go to the Nauducitas tomorrow via San Justo. Take Mala casa
Tropilla

Nov. 19.

Alfredo and Robson started for Nanducitas taking mala Cara
Tropilla and pack mule and going by bridge at San Justo
as Salado is very high. Parared east rodeo to Desimbechar.
Ramayon's peon from Reconquista brought noticia that
Negro and Salan were at Funda nueva, and would not
entregar them to him. Celmaed (peon that Alfredo sent
from San Pedro) came today begins work tomorrow.

G. Remollere and Antonio Lara arrived on way to St. Fe.
Troop of cattle from Helvetia escaping ericient. Lost in
corral tonight on way to Malabrigo.

- 20 -

Batchured cow [X]. Caught two more of the matreros horses
running in camp. Sent one to Baldomero with "Verde" marks.
Changueared this afternoon.

- 21 -

Hefonso and Celmaed revisaring the quebrado in rincónado.
Furres casto took away were they had thrown into our
camp near rincónado. Trying to burn camp on account
of garrapatas. Hot north wind.

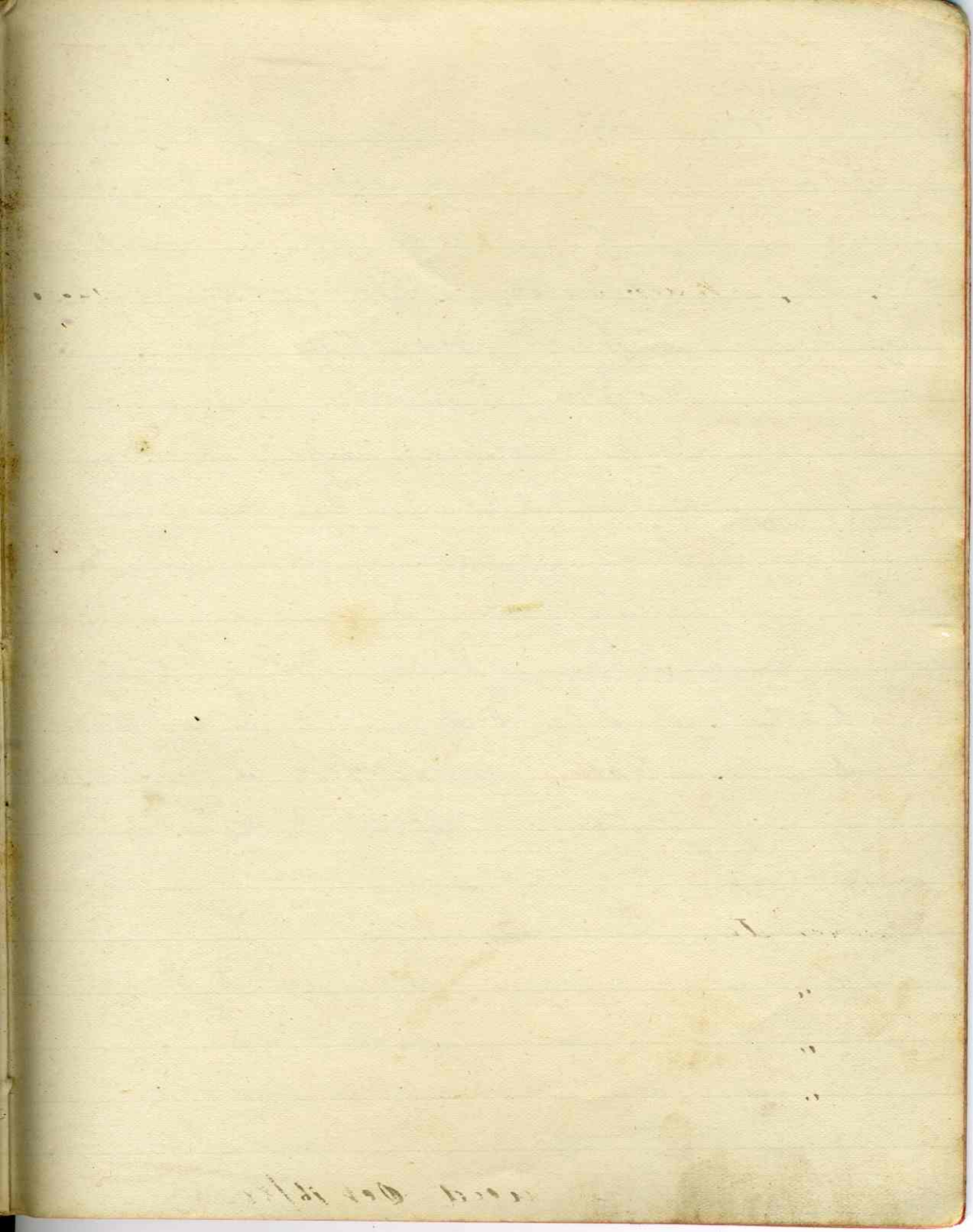
