Had letters from home. Want tropa down by 10 de Nobre.

13 SUNDAY—17 aft Trin [286-79]

Translation of K. Edward the Confessor

Had east rodeo on and capared about 80 bulls. Ceno and Climaco (outsiders) helped. Ceno left to join Agilby for Corrientes to buy horses. Gave Ceno \$24.00 and (\$17.00 private) to buy horses. Fine day.

Fire Insurance Days of Grace expire

Don Hipolito left for Buenos Ayres. Alfredo & Donkin were at rodeo rincónado Triondas. Peicho and Demasio left for Pajaro Blanco to look for stray mares of Donkins.

15 TUESDAY [288-77]

Scotch Law Sittings begin

Alfredo was up at Carabacas rodeo. Donkin and Coleman were at Calchaqui station. Sent Manuel Gomez <sup>horse</sup> to go to Puerto Pajaro Blanca.

16 WEDNESDAY [289-76]

Ignacio & Elia went to Malabrigo with low colonist cart and plow to get fixed. Butchered cow. Patricio alone here with mother. Besides Robson Donkin & Coleman.

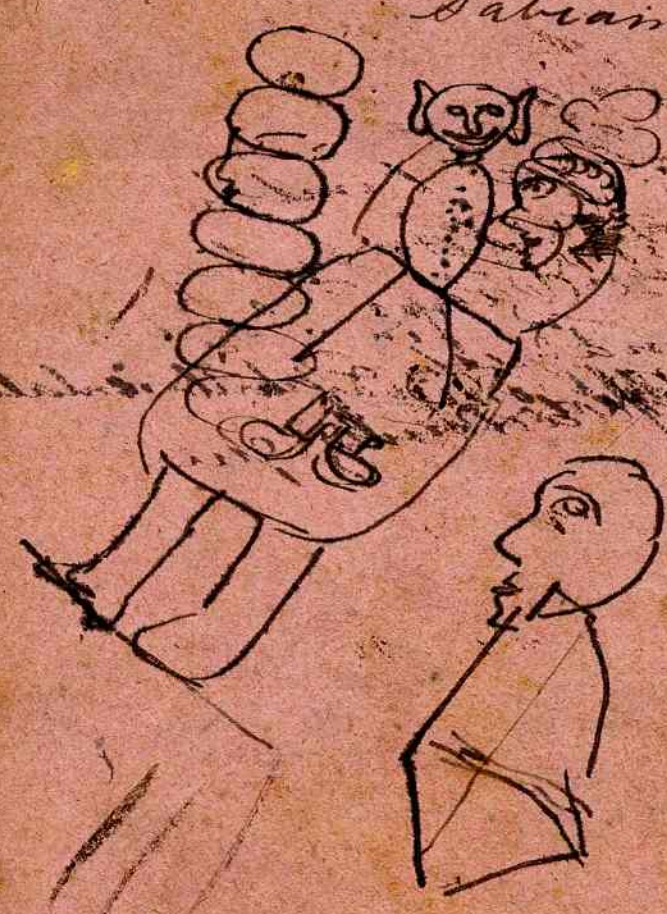

St. Luke, Evan.

Robson with Donkin and Colman left for Malabrigo  
to dispatch cart. took 202. along. Pedro and Demesio  
came back from Costa, brought a mare & pairo from  
Señuelo and the alaca & madrina and two potran-  
cas from Morgans. The pairo horse Kirt had with  
troops up north and 2 or 3 mares supposed to be at  
viuda Galley's encargared Eugenio to bring.  
Looked rainy but turned out to be fine days.

## 19 SATURDAY [392-73]

Juan Antonio fixed thatch of house a bit.  
Alfredo found ostrich eggs - 17. Fine hot day.  
Fritz Kennel stops the night on way to Orientala.

## 20 SUNDAY - 18 aft Trin [393-72]

Rained slightly this morning. Men went hunting.  
Nothing going on.

Baltazar Bermudas came this evening with 28 men from Corrientes. Gave him a vaquilla. in return for for meat given us outside. He reports very bad trip over - river very high. Pulperos Tremollier came back from Buenos Ayres. Alfredo was over at puesto.

## 22 TUESDAY [295-70]

Had west rides on (12) and captured about 35 bulls. This afternoon went in camp and captured some padres. Robson came back from Malabrigo. reports delay in having east fixed. Donkin & Coleman stop at Morcaus.

## 23 WEDNESDAY [296-69]

Donkin & Coleman came back from Malabrigo. Sent Feicho to Malabrigo to let Terico know about taking tropa down. Lemisio brought two loads of fire wood. Looks rainy. -

Michaelmas Law Sittings begin. ● 2<sup>h</sup> 26<sup>m</sup> P.M.

Donkin & Coleman went to Calchagui and brought Wilkinson on a pased. Sent Demisid up to Larguiras fence to help Ignacio down with cart, as Eliu (the boy) came & said was broke. Sent Patricio to Chapuis to ask rodes for Saturday. Butchered machora ouzulla  
Fine day

25 FRIDAY [298-67]  
(St. Crispin, Mart)

Demisid went to Calchagui and brought out Parry who had sent telegram yesterday coming on a hunt. Picho turned up from Malabrigo with Perico & 3 peones. Begin to part tomorrow. Ignacio came with cart, had only broken lance. sacked him. Picho had paid his bill of \$1.50

26 SATURDAY [299-66]

Parted 42 novillas & bulls of Eriondas racionada Espin today and this afternoon parted 128 novillas from east rodes. Larguiras sent 12 novillas (R) down to be taken to Larguiras <sup>pro guinea</sup> widow (d. Jomey) — Perico (capataz) Mercedes Loreyo Barza, Marco, Paraguay Zacharia, Jose Almada today. Blumaco & Sixto Baraza worked. Weather looks bad.

27 SUNDAY — 19 aft Trin [300-65]

Rained some this morning. Had west rodes of (1/2) and parted about 136 novillas. rodes very slippery. Same gente as yesterday worked. Butchered cow.

St. Simon &amp; St. Jude, App.

Had south side of west oodoo on and parted out about 130 novillas. Some novillas cleared out this morning. - Took them across the arroya and counted them after parting out a lot of manecas etc 426 altogether: of which 12 are Languias 6 Donkins and 1 Tregathens. Sent Demasio to station for quia. Same gente as yesterday worked. Perico goes as Capataz - and the peones who go - Marcelino. Lorenzo Bargo - Marco - Paraguay - Jaccharia - Jose Almada, and they try to take fidel the Paraguay along. (7 altogether) Gave Perico vale on Don Jorge for 50. for expenses. Climaco & Sisto Barazza <sup>Chapin's \$</sup> 29 TUESDAY [302-63] go along tomorrow. Gave along 1 vaquilla for tonight can't take more along on account of bulls. Hot heavy days -

- Tuesday 29. -

Sisto Barazza & Climaco came back from the tropa. They recounted the catt in corral at Iriondas 424 - The indians from puerto were here - gave them \$50.00 vale on Capataz on a/c ahead. Alfredo & Parry were down at rincónado recorriendo.

30 WEDNESDAY [303-62]

Manuel Gomez & gente (10) passed on way to Monte Aguara - he shot tiger in rincónado. Hot days. Paid Climaco \$11 on Perico's c/c

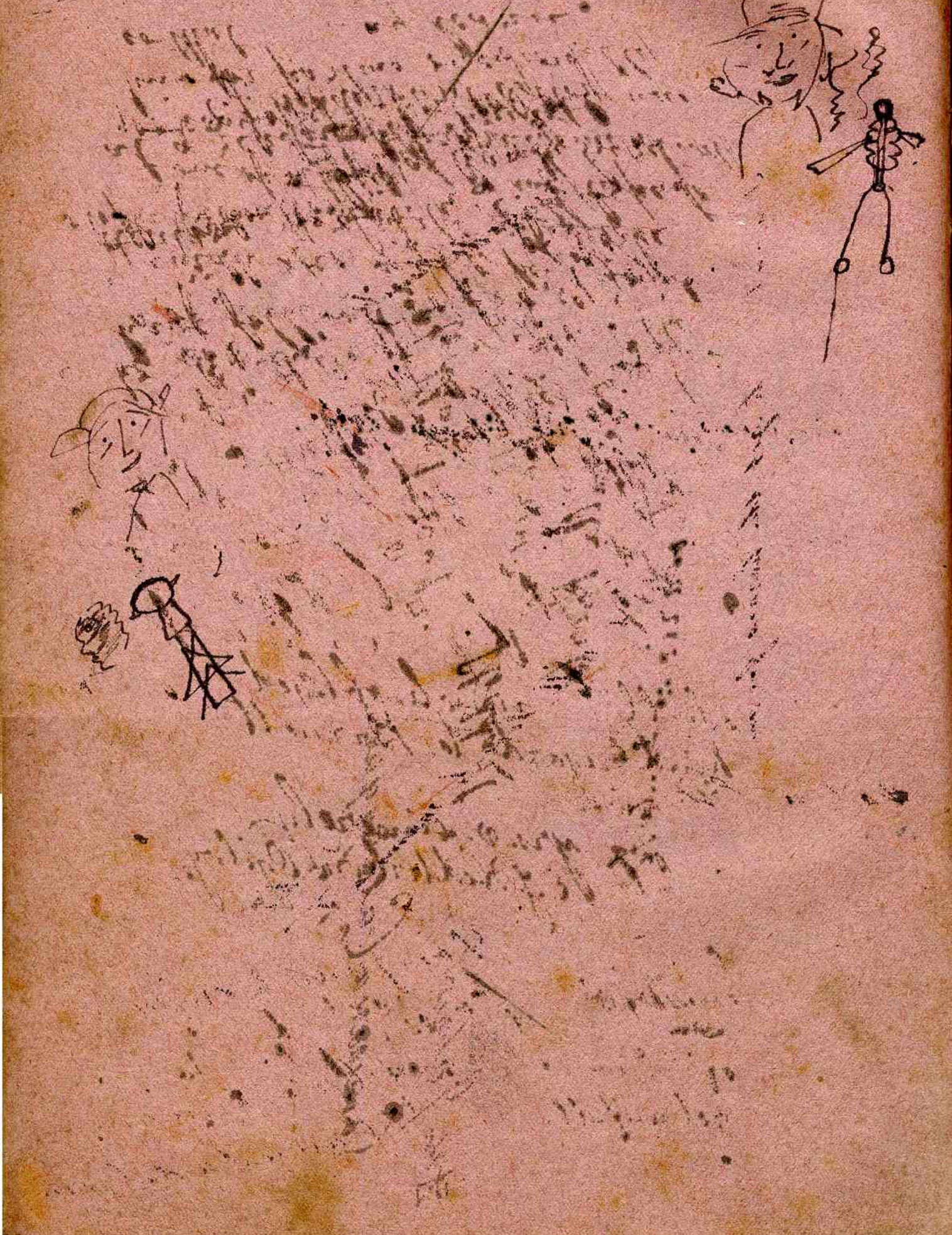
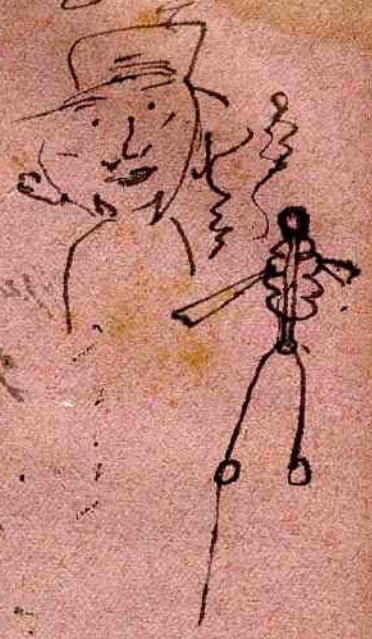

awaiting me here for pay from tropa. Donkin  
& Parry are still outside where we are build-  
ing large galpon 17 x 8 yds. Hot weather.

St Catherine, V. &amp; M.

Had east rodeo but the storm coming up prevented disembarcaring - Rained nearly all forenoon. Butchered old cow. Alfredo & Robson were down at Chapuis and rec'd \$17.00 left by Pedrito Guibert for tropa started Aug 17. Arranged with Perico about the tropa down south. The gastos on road were \$31.00 -  
 passing Salado \$10.00 - wages \$376. total \$397.00 making  
 6 part 2 other pesos of with caquillo a \$3.00.  
 1.00 per lid to take animals down. Pd all the men to Perico & Maclungo except Zacharia.

## 26 TUESDAY [330-35]

Dispatched cart with Demasio & Claurio for outside. Got from Don Hipolito Door, window, empty barrel, bag biscuits etc and at station got 8 quintal wire, 47 lb fine wire, gallitas, sugar, bag yerba, rice, bag may. St and encargas for indians. Alfredo was at Balchaqui. Peicho found about 20 mares in Torres suernada. Hot day.

## 27 WEDNESDAY [331-34]

Marked 11 milch cow calfs. and captured 7 tortugas. Made contract with Juan Benavidez to agaserenciar catth for 4 months and build puesto and corral for \$400. Paid Don Hipolito bill and paid him cheque \$300. and cash \$32.50. also gave Peicho \$500 for expenses as Alfredo & Robson leave tomorrow for Mistlar. Will begin to move cattle next week on Friday.

Climaco with cart from outside and Juan Antonio arrived. The rest of gente to tropic cattle outside came today about a dozen. Getting everything ready to move cattle outside.

## 6 FRIDAY [340-25]

St. Nicolas, Bp.

Put west (north) ~~roads~~ on for Iriondas and Livia to part. The capataz of Iriondas and wanted to part their cattle into camp. but Alfredo would not let them and wrote to Chapuis to that effect. So they parted until 3 o'clock and then a storm coming up before quite finishing took their *finueta* to *puesta* to lock in. Men began to work in storm at 3 P.M. except Zacharia who begins at night herd. Hired new *peon* for Pichlo ~~from outside~~ and also a *peon* for Jose the Paraguay for outside.

## 7 SATURDAY [341-24]

O 9<sup>h</sup> 52<sup>m</sup> A.M.

Tropico left for *Mistolar*. <sup>about 2300</sup> Slept *costo* *copra*. A heavy thunderstorm, Alfredo also left. Lot cattle escaped back.

Alfredo came back from Mistolar. Had but time getting across Calchaqui with troops over there 3 days with cattle resacared. Had to pass about 400 with lasso, account in day book at Mistolar entrusted to Jose who takes care of them. 2175 of which, 468 are orejanas. Had an awful lot of rain in the last 10 days and the Espin is very high. Found Robson here yet. Feicho hired another peon Elias who was peonero in Invernada.

17 TUESDAY [351-14]  
Oxford Michaelmas Term ends

Had on west rodeo to disambuchar. To calculate about 1300 of ours left on it. Hip. Tremallise, left pulperia. Alfredo was at Carutacas this afternoon. Dispatched one of the troops men old clip from Pajero Blanco.

18 WEDNESDAY [352-13]  
Ember Day

Had east rodeo on to disambuchar. good many disambuchados. garapatas also beginning. Butchard Inranka novilla sent to ask rodeo at sinconada Espin. Gente left for there. Awful hot day and looks like storm.

Alefredo & Robson went down to rodeo Espin of Trinidad. Espin very high. Parted out about 150 and the men sleep at ensenada. Sent Climaco to Margarita to look for genti, came back with Lena and a companion. It was an awful hot day and a storm blew past.

## 20 FRIDAY [354-11]

Ember Day

Genti parted at rodeo "Lapera Racine" parted about 60 and then brought the cattle home. Alefredo went on to station gave Capata's check for 600 to give vales on to. Butchered old cows.

## 21 SATURDAY [355-10]

St. Thomas, Ap. Ember Day. Michaelmas Law Sittings end. Shortest Day. Winter begins

Put on rest rodeo of cattle left parted out all cows (50) with small calves and the Trinidad genti parted out into camp. about half rodeo was theirs. Got finishing this afternoon. 8 men worked with their horses this morning and 8 this afternoon and all rounder on rodeo tonight. Very hot days.

## 22 SUNDAY—4 in Advent [356-9]

Total Eclipse of Sun invisible at Greenwich ● 0<sup>h</sup> 52<sup>m</sup> P.M.

Very hot days. Sunday  
Dispatched tropa this morning early. Helped them across arroya and out of gate. None escaped. Chapuis genti also helped. About 1320 altogether.

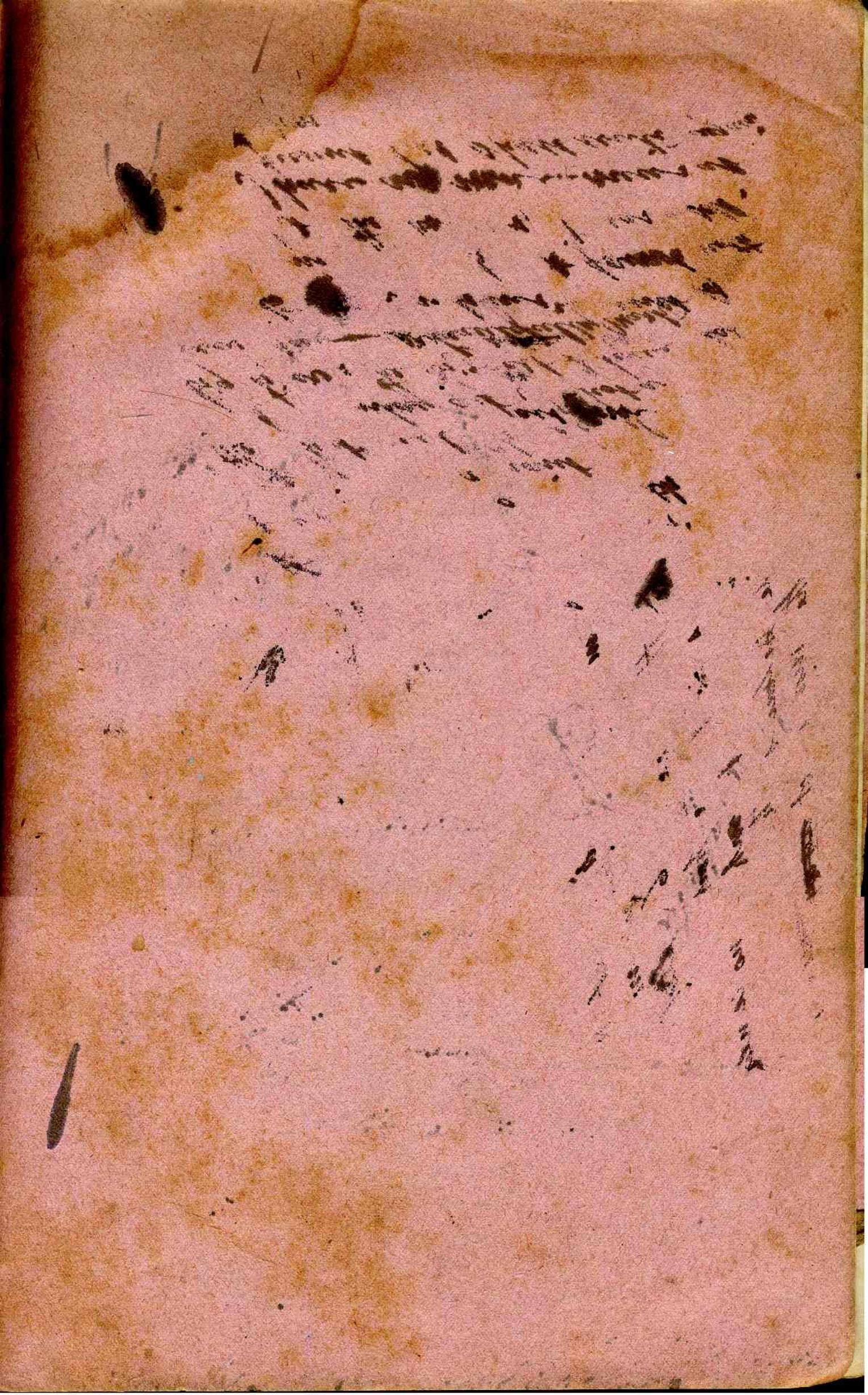

St. John, Evan. Holiday at Law Offices

Alfreds came back from outside with gente. had arrived yesterday morning with tropa. Had 4 1/2 days on road. were 1 1/2 days at paso Calchaqui. Entrigared the cattle to old Juan at his puesto. 1225 of which 256 were archanas. He also had 14 marked animales milch cattt. - not in any count. The rest of his tambara cattle went in the other cattt and counted with them. - Had 19 peones in last tropa. Chapuis and gente came tonight to part tomorrow. - Looks stormy.

## 28 SATURDAY [362-3]

Innocents Day. Holiday at Law Offices.  
Childermas

Had a heavy storm last night and a good deal of rain so did not put rodeo on until this afternoon when Chapuis parted out to rodeo simulá. Leno and 7 men rondar as he arriars this tropita about 800. About 1/3 of east rodeo.

## 29 SUNDAY - 1 aft Christmas [363-2]

5<sup>h</sup> 17<sup>m</sup> A.M.

Helped Leno across the river with his cattle none escaped river high. Put on rest of rodeo with the men at noon and Chapuis parted into camp about 1/3 of the cattle. We then tried to march the cattle across the canada but had awful work and about 250 mostly calves had to take back to rodeo to rondar as it was late. Some calves escaped into camp.

Passed the point of cattle over the cascades that would not pass last night, and then helped the troop (about 1400) across the Eschin which is swimming. A few calves seem to be in the camp without mothers but will separate tomorrow. Chapuis left. Alfredo stops till tomorrow when cart leaves for outside. Nelson & Rich and family stop until finished parting cattle. It was a very hot day.
