

Butchered on the 5<sup>th</sup>  
hard frost. Dried the leaves of  
the ombus at last. Received 500. from  
Mr Martí. - Hot Hauling palms  
from Palmar. - Brought 15 more novillas  
to break in from potrero. -

July 10.

Carts made a trip & brought leña. -  
Ortiz working in garden. Another frost.

- 11 -

Hard frost. 1 cart went to Balde Negro  
& bring hides. & 1 cart & take  
& puestos Ortiz. Butchered cow.

- 12 -

Another hard frost. & cold day.  
Elia & sonnes making a palm  
corral in Palmar for oxen. -  
A. recurring south puestos. -

- 13 -

Had on video in potrero and  
parted out 127 animals to camp,  
as potrero is overstocked.

Another hard frost. Butchered  
old cow. - 14 - no frost

Sunday. Miguel left for Calehaguai  
& buy maize. Carts go tomorrow.  
Antonio Moreiro came. -  
J. Martí was here, & brought his  
cart. which we send in with ours.

- 15 -

Sent 43 bullocks & 2 novillas to  
Palmar with Eulogio to take care  
of them up there. The carts 2 of ours  
1 of Martí went to Calchagui to bring  
out maize etc. - 43 bullocks to Palmar 12  
& Calehaguai 4 plow = 59. J. Moreiro left.  
Ortiz began harrowing maize stalks  
together. - N. wind cloudy & cold. -

July 16 / 95

Frost & hard north wind today, warm.  
Butchered old cow. - Elias found one of the  
new bulls dead on Salado. Dona Juana  
& Mea were here. Sent 50.00 to Old Juan. --  
Ortiz harrowing maize stalks. -

- 17 -

Elias with Patricio and Juan Gomez left  
for La Camila to part before they move  
their cattle away. A. recurring monsoon. -  
One of the young bullocks died estranged

- 18 -

Ortiz harrowing & cleaning up maize  
stalks. Robson, Sumsdale, Toddington,  
Verstygne turned up, and we had a  
paseo up to Palmar but mosquitos fearful  
bad. - 19 -

Visitors left again for Molle. Elias came  
back from La Camilla, parted 6 calves  
out & no big animals which seems  
very strange. - Miguel also came back  
from Calchagui, reports having bought 300  
maize @ 63' with bag. - Isabella of monos  
lost since 17<sup>th</sup>. Camp full of mosquitos  
& hard north wind blowing. -

- 20 -

Butchered cow. Carts turned up this  
evening from Calchagui bringing 3000 kg  
maize, 1 bag flour, 2 box soap, sugar etc.  
and also Martí's things. Ortiz cleaned  
chera of maize stalks.

- 21 -

Sunday. - Miguel & Elias recurred way  
up in monsoon. Cattle go very far on  
account of the mosquitos. -  
Another day of hard north wind. -

- 22 -

Alfredo recurred as far as Wampite  
Gimenez. Miguel recurred as far North

- July. 1895. -

as last Palmer. Elias also recovered.  
Morros still missing. First mauga  
of locust passed north ward. South  
wind tonight after 6 days N wind.  
Cloudy weather. Cut some orquenes  
at pueblo. - Hunting maize stalks  
in chacra.

Druzy day & tonight began raining.  
Temporalish weather. -

Butchered cow

Noticias that tropilla of redomones  
& some mares had gone towards  
Calchaqui.

- 24 -

Miguel left with his tropilla & Jose Higinio  
to campia the missing horses & mares and  
also to bring out Johnnie if he comes on  
the 26<sup>th</sup>. Alfredo went up to Martini &  
parted out 4 animals. J. Martini stops the  
night. - Rained last night and rained  
again this evening. -

- 25 -

Cast left for Calchaqui bringing out the 6  
bags of maize from Redonquite & Johnnies  
things if he turns up. - Rained some last  
night & is quite warm & cloudy. Guess  
will have lots of rain. Nothing going on.

- 26 -

Recovered the 4 south pueblos. Nothing  
new. report Cabals' cattle have all  
taken to the monte last week during  
the north winds. - Cloudy cool day. -  
Butchered cow. But 5 orquenes from most

- 27 -

Fine spring day. Miguel came back  
from Calchaqui found 19 horses &  
mares near Calchaqui. Johnnie & Biscay

come on Aug 2. according to telegrama.

Marked 2 madas alts 1 hembrona

- 28 -

Sunday. Juan the indio found the fence  
cut in two places on the 2<sup>nd</sup> angle from  
his toldo. suppose the morros b pieces.  
At Ortiz's lobrinos were taken through by the  
indians. Elias recovered to Laguna del  
Perro. Hughes is there. a cuadillo of about  
12 of our cattle are there. - Peones &  
Antonio Moreira turned up to make tripa.  
Cloudy day, muggy. Wind turned south  
after hard north wind all morning. -

- 29 -

Cut on Palmer rodeo about 4000 head, and  
parted about 108 old and ugly cows & send  
south. Afterwards drove cattle to Salado.  
Cattle look very well, about dozen small calves.  
Antonio Moreira, <sup>capataz</sup> Antonio Pinto & comp. Manano,  
Eduarte, Rojales, Patricio, & Agustin worked on  
their own horses. Butchered old cow  
Sent Juan Gomez & Vera to take out quias.  
Juan reported tracks of 5 indians, 2 on horse-  
back & 3 on foot seen by Santos Berra <sup>Send Juan to track them up Santos</sup> coming this way. - Muggy morning but  
clear afternoon.

- 30 -

Cut on Salado rodeo and parted out  
74 old cows. Same gentle as yesterday  
worked. Tropa went to pueblo. - Tropers  
butchered a cow at pueblo. - Foggy  
morning but fine day. N. wind again. -

- 31 -

Cut on Mistolar rodeo and parted out  
about 725 old cows to complete the troupe  
of 300. also 6 black calves lost on road.  
They lock in at Tela tonight. Paid 2  
outside men \$18.00 for 3 days work.  
Fine day. slight frost. - Butchered old cow. -

August 1 / 95.-

Despatched the troja 300 old cows.  
6 calves to eat. Gan Moreno 60.3  
peones are Moreno (capataz), Linto,  
Eduardo, Rojelio, Patricio & Mariano. -  
Brought two loads of tales from Palmar  
1. Sent subis Benites with cart  
to Calchagui. - Splendid day. -  
Don Juan Gomez came last night from  
Vera with quia which cost 1.00 gastos  
\$ 9.50. -

August 2/

J. Gomez left with two horses to bring out  
Johnnie & Bischoff. It was a hot  
stormy looking day. - Began working  
on corridor back of house. -

- 3 -

Funtared horses in camp. - Awaited  
J. & Bischoff who did not turn up.  
Harder, A. Hartmuth & C. Rohr turned  
up & stopt the night. rather knocked  
up by heat. - Hot day NE wind.

- 4 -

Sunday. Visitors left, lent them trofilla  
oscuras to go back with. Tratared  
with Messrs Harder & Hartmuth for  
camp twixt Calchagui & Waupula  
5 yrs. @ \$ 2000 for 3 leagues per yr.  
Will let them know by tomorrow. -  
Johnnie & Bischoff came this morning,  
for their annual hunt, bro's tent along  
etc. - Miguel went down to La Camilla  
to see about the cattle which are  
being moved away. Warm pleasant  
day. -

- 5 -

Getting ready to go out with tomorrow.  
Hot day & looks sunny again.

Aug. - 18 / 95. -

Came back yesterday noon from  
outside party was Johnnie, Bischoff,  
Alfredo, Elias, Ewaldino, Juan, Jose  
Higinio & Juan Antonio. Left at night  
Estero Las Tejas, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> old camping  
ground North of Laguna del Perro, near  
road to Chilcas, 4 & 5<sup>d</sup> head waters of  
Sarmocita, 6 & 7 near confluence of  
Sarmocita & Golondrina in monte. 8<sup>th</sup>  
south of east picado from Cucia del  
Tigre in monte, 9 & 10<sup>th</sup> Estero las Tejas.  
1<sup>st</sup> home. - Bag; 1 gran bestia, 3 gato-  
niza, 2 jama, 2 aquara, 1 curvo,  
6 chancho negro, 1 chancito cibato  
5 jabali, 1 gato morra, 5 guazu quiras,  
1 cuati, 1 leon, 3 aquaracitos vivos,  
blue eagle. - 2 indian horses (1 mare). -  
Saw any amount of indian tracks, &  
Morells cattle & tracks, Indians stole  
at Laguna del Perro on the 4<sup>th</sup>. Had rain  
on the 8<sup>th</sup> but not much water outside.  
Miguel parted at La Camilla where they  
have taken their cattle away. -  
No Mosquitos & fine weather but want  
rain to bring water for cattle. -  
Bolton, Lunsdaine, & Verschuren also camped  
at Estero los Tejas with us for two days. -

- 19 -

South wind again. Immense mangle of locust  
passed northwards. Sent cart to Calchagui  
with skins etc. Visited Trakes & Martini this  
afternoon. Miguel went to sleep at Baldemus  
to recover more tomorrow. - Driving cattle  
to Salado for water.

Aug 24/95.

Came back from Calchaqui at noon.  
Had gone in with Johnnie & Bischoff  
on the 20<sup>th</sup>. Also went to Espin to see  
Livingston about posts & went to  
Vera and Stevens saw mills. -  
Rumours of Revolution & Indian  
alarms up north. Nothing new on  
here. The corridor back of house  
finished. Weather fine had nice  
rain on 19<sup>th</sup> night. -

- 15 -

Sunday. Parted out Elias cattle  
from patreros & take them to Felix  
puerto. - about 37 head. Warm day.  
Clouds rainy.

- 26 -

Parted out at Sucero 3 animals.  
Very strong cold south wind.  
Butchered cow. -

- 27 -

Miguel, Elias, Checho, Julian, J. Gomez  
& Wenceslado left to part at Media  
Luna. At slight frost this morning  
but N.E. wind again & warmish  
- 28 -

Nothing going. East wind.  
J. Higinio came back from Malabriga.

- 29 -

Oy died (young). Apartadores came  
back from Media Luna - parted out  
about 147 and did not finish. No one  
there to give them rodeo. -

- 31 -

Alfredo went to Calchaqui, & Estacion  
Espin. yesterday & came back tonight.  
Sent contract for Guanpilí camp to  
Buenos Ayres to be signed by Hartenbeck  
Cia. Bet his car loads of posts

from Livingston about 380 @ 1.00 the  
set & last was freight is \$99.90 per  
car load. - gave an order on Martí for  
the amount. Mat Bower, Livingstons, &  
\_\_\_\_\_. Stormy weather, sawdust rain  
but no rain. Butchered yesterday. -

Sept 1 -

Sunday. - Beastly cold cloudy day  
and looks like it will rain any  
moment. -

- 2 -

Put on Palmar rodeo <sup>Butchered cow.</sup> for the neighbors  
but only Lucero people turned up. -  
Marked 29 calves in corral & capared  
about 22 bulls mostly ageno.  
Indians stole the horses at Ewaldino  
puerto at Palmar including 3 from  
the sofa there (1 pedimento from istancia)  
about horses Ewaldino & Juan followed  
up immediately. - Cool nice day. -

Tonight late boy from puerto <sup>Tele</sup> came with  
noticia that Indians had taken 23 horses  
from there. - 3 -

Gathered horses together to follow Indians  
up but rain came on and rained about  
4 hours after breakfast. - Poor old macho  
stolen too, & mula gateado & 2 other mules  
from puerto. - Weather permitting Alfredo  
follows up with Casimiro Guy, Elias,  
Wenceslado, J. Higinio & Checho, & Ewaldino  
apart if they turn up from following  
the Indians yesterday. <sup>Tele</sup> ~~apart~~  
manos left at puerto that is all. -

- 4 -

Left to follow up the Indians who had  
stolen <sup>3 mules</sup> estancia horses from 5 mares  
from puerto. Felix and <sup>7 2 miles</sup> 4 estancia horses  
from Ewaldino's puerto besides 8 <sup>Ewaldino</sup> of his
