Thursday. Tickinson says Word had letter from Widow Array to get highest offers for her camp. Left Resistencia in new Ford 7 am & a boy to help drive. Found roads very bad after recent rains. About a league from Picada Varela got stuck about 2 1/2 hours were pulled out by a Camion #10. Got to Zupallar at 5 PM & to here about to coming by Estancia Vermijo. New house looks fine

6 Winter, Warm day 24 E wind. Slight. Had a walk at Rhodes grass first sown & looks very promising & spreading & ought to be a success. To wind mill south & then across to Col. Zupallar where Ahumado gave us mate & grape fruit. In afternoon to Puerto Zupallar & got a mosquito net as flies are bad in house. Steam of P Vermijo hangs on 29" about. Mr & Mrs Armitage 2 kids & Mrs Brownings called in the evening. Sent word to Hardy to buy mucho balls at 5 de Resistencia at 3 de Pichincha. Cattle looking well except Plantel which are on this side & garrubato

Winter

OCTUBRE

25

Warm day N E 35°. Looks stormy this evening. Went at 7 am in car to see R. Uruburu camp which I had bought & was very pleased with it, especially the low fat & monte rate on S side. Also went to Guastis & saw mill not far from S E corner of Uruburu camp. Getting pawn posts to fence this camp at 70 cts. Also called on at Wards Croag camp. Did altogether 64 kil. In afternoon jolted around place & am very pleased about the Cocksfoot & Grama Rhodes.

26

Sunday. Rained 98" in last night. Fine rain & today over cast cool & wind. Did not go into camp on 4 of wet. Inquired about the Vinal plague, only 2 or 3 plants seen by Capataz. Hamilton bought Mrs Armitage for lunch & tea & her 2 girls. Guess Armitage & the Brownings will have bad roads on way back from Resistencia to Cia Vermijo Estancia.

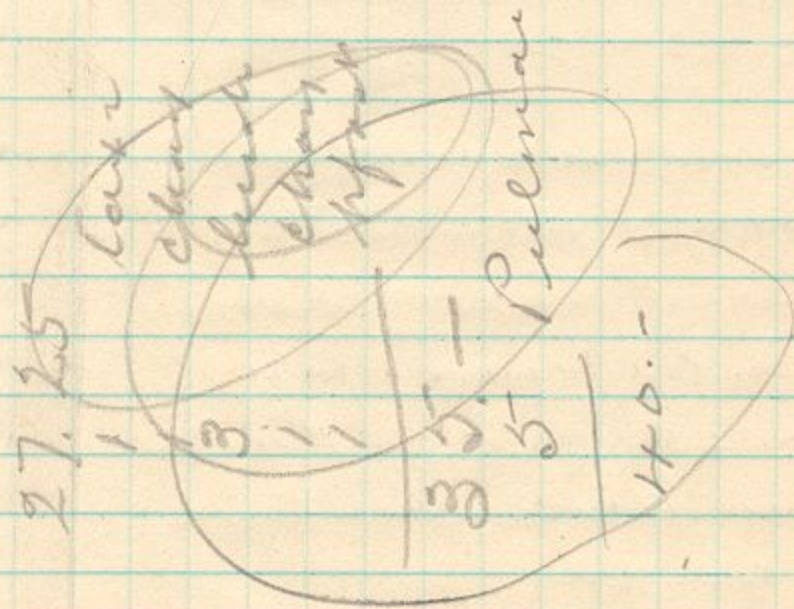
