Lilly's wedding.. Elias stops as encargado.

Hartnecks to buy cattle. Lauricio Rodriguez
undertakes to deliver oxen here @ \$36.-

Held every thing all night. Had parted
at Hartnecks 9 animals, at M. Frare 22,
& at Morales 16 animals.. Also parted
50 old cows of Dionisio today & put
them into potrero to fatten. trad. was
\$18.- apiece & 1/2 profits on selling. —

— Domingo the alambrador finished potrero

on the 6th. The other alambrador getting
on all right.. Had counter marked a
trito for C. Gay for one that died after
he sold him.. Weather very dry here
and only had one small shower on the 3rd,
and camps getting very dry.. Julian
Sanchez beginning to move his cattle to
Miguel's old place. Last night about 1000
locked in corral. Miguel also sent about
200 head up to Cacique, of cattle he rec'd
from Julian a medios. Indians about.

— 10 —

A & Forrester were up at Alambrado costa
Galchagui. Baldomero Espinoza passed
over 200 posts Salado. - Elias & his men
deepened well at Encinada. Hot day
& looks stormy. Tito Martinez here today
looking for work..

— 11 —

Had on rodeo dela Tapia for Diellus
who did not finish, but parted about
300.. Made trade with Silvano Quichelud
to buy about 800 head of cattle @ \$21.
cows & novillos 2 yrs old.. Parted about
15 old cows into potros. Butchered capon
and old cow.. Miguel came from Caldera
with some of his things..

— 12 —

Had on rodeo del Mistlar. about 1500,
Dielar parted about 50 animals. Seca
getting bad. Robson came and stops night..
Good Friday tomorrow..

— 13 —

Good Friday.. Holiday. M. Faire was here,
settled a/c with him.. Pelado Rodriguez came
at midnight. agreed to send a man Sunday
night to Urbano Aralos to receive 40 when

more or less at \$35^c and milk cows about 30.
at \$9.00. Silvano Michelini sent word would
not be able to deliver cattle until after the 22nd.
Warm day dry and looks stormy. -

- 14 -

Baldomero went over to Miguel's to part
found none, but 1 cow of DR which had got
out of potrero. - put some agujos into potrero.
A. & Forrester went over to Robsons where rodeo
was on also. Elias & Peones went there but only
1 novillo vaguilla, which we left there. -
Cleaned place up. Carts leave tomorrow for
Calchaqui. - Last wind, dusty. Butchered cow.
Domingo Ariani & 2 peones making varillas alambre.

Sunday. Had on rodeo del potrero, and
counted ^{old} cows of Godoy's mark 46 - 4 had
escaped. Today & Miguel Train were here. Bought
the 50 cows outright @ \$18.00. Handled
cuentas with Train & Godoy. Sent Hilario
Martinez to Calchaqui to receive oven from
Santos Rodriguez and pay for them through
Hartnick's. - Julian Saucy was here for break-
fast: he passed with about 1000 head of
cattle for Miguel's old place (Martinez's tapera) 2nd
trip. - A. & Forrester were up at Train's this
evening as in the morning he is leaving for
Cacique with his cattle. Stormy morning, north
wind. - 16 -

Domingo & 4 peones making varillas. Cafarati
harrowing. Elias dug pozo at tapera. -

Butchered cow & remodeled corral. -

A & Forrester secured potrero fence & camp. -

Salado rising and pretty high already. -

Potrero Salado fence is as follows - from river
to corner 1930 meters, 35 torniquets

from corner to Salado 4150 mts, 48 torniquets. -

Fine day. N.E. wind & getting more towards
rain which is badly wanted. -

April 17/1900

Men recurred camp and looked after corral in afternoon.. Hilario Martinez who went to receive Pilado Rodriguez' men came back late last night and said they were no good and not fit to receive.. A. & Torrester were down at Elias, Damasio's puesto. -

Very hot day and seca getting serious.. Making vanillas.

- 18 -

The 3 carts came back last night from Galchagui bringing stones, encuendadas from B.A., and 40 bags of maiz. Parted out all the chicape from potrero, & marked 31 calves from the old cows marked them and turned them into camp.. Sesto Martinez was here.. - Another very hot day, strong north wind.. Finished making vanillas! two new men began work with Tomingo Iribarne -

- 19 -

Marked Frakes calves this morning 36 - some small ones left yet (about 5) Entregando a los to Garcia the alambrador. Iribarne with his gente passed the rest of the posts over the Salado ^{the} 3 carts came loaded with posts from Salado.. - Robson came tonight.. Very hot day. N. wind. Sesto Hilario Martinez made trade with Paulo Gonzales to haul loads out from Galchagui @ \$10. & dormientos as far as Mistral @ 35^{cts} each..

- 20 -

Butchered a toruno.. A. & Torrester recurred to Euvaldinos & Jarcias at alambrado costa Calchagui. Silvano Michelini is here, set day for 23 to make broap cows & novillos at his place.. Sent Hilario Martinez to Galchagui to see about Hartmicks men.. (to buy) The 3 carts took posts to Angostura. Iribarne began fencing in new chacra. Hot, sultry day 90° looks stormy.. Big seca, grass all getting dried up ^{f. Benítez} with sandias for sale here.

Carts came back from Somolae..

Baldomero & Peru went down to Elias who marked his calves (45).

Cafferati harrowing..

Hambradores making chacra fence..

Very hot day but had nice shower of rain in afternoon which will freshen things up.

Sunday... Made trade with Cafferati for him to take chacra on halves give him land broken up, house, 3 K meat per day, 1 K yuta 1 K sugar per muk, maize salt. give him \$25⁰⁰ per month for breaking up camp. The guis crops harvested, and are obliged to buy his share at Galchaguí valuations. Promised to buy his tambara catch @ \$12 or \$13 a corte. - Go in afternoon to sleep at Elias pueste on way to Micheluds & make topa.. Had another fine rain in night, very hard towards costa Galchaguí..

Alfredo & Forrester came back from Micheluds where had made toop. Parted from Silvano Michelud & 2 brothers. 691 cows @ 19.⁵⁰ & 152 novillos @ \$25⁰⁰ and 1. big novillo from Jose Michelud in exchange for an orchano calf from Ioms Poi. - Total \$44 \$16.929. Will get the money thru giro on bank on Santa Fe. - Drawings & 11 men took topa (began yesterday). mean as far as Tara. gave him value \$150. + \$5.- Cash. - Came back by Somolai where Osborne began today the divisorio fence at angasterra.. 2 carts of Paolo Gonzales with 50 quintal alambre pua, 10 of oval wire, 4 bags alfa seed, as far as Imsilav. - Cold clear weather. South end of camp dry. Hartmick & Melba had been here yesterday with couch borrowed from

Alfredo & gñh went over to Haciendas to give a
hand at marking. Marked about 3..

Paolo Gonzales carts ^{had} brought 50 rolls of pua
10 rolls of 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ gal, 4 bags alfa seed, 2 buckets
3 marks from Calchaqui as far as Musters ..
From there today sent 5 rolls pua, 5 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ to
Tribaine at Divisoria fence. & brought the
rest to the estancia .. Sent Forresters things
to Calchaqui on pack horse .. It was a
fine day but looks rainy ..

- 26 -

Forrester left at 1 A.M. for Buenos Aires ..
Getting ready for marcacion tomorrow ..
Sent pua, quid vanillas to Jorgearia on
costa Calchaqui .. It was a fine cloudy day.
Butchered novillo of Frakes mark (st.)

- 27 -

Had on rodeo Salado about 1000 head.
Parted out Agnos cows with ^{cattle in splendid condition} rancheros calves, &
also calves too small to mark .. Had a
good luck in & finished marking by 12 o'clock
Marked 261 calves (1 was tambara).

Lislo Martinez & his peones helped. Victor Ojido,
Pedro Benividz, & 4 paisanos outsiders helped ..
Butchered fat cow .. It was a pleasant warm
day ..

- 28 -

Had on north part of Estancia rodeo
about 2000, & had a good luck in - Same
gñh as yesterday worked .. Marked 502
calves .. Had parted good many too small
ones out at rodeo. Splendid calves, & left
a lot without "caparing". Weather drizzled
some & looks like atemporal tonight ..

5 yuntas worked. Dñllus sent men to
part out their cows and calves. about 7 calves.

Apr 29.-

Sunday. Temporal blowing, drizzled good last night & today, so there was no marking. Domingo the Alambrador came back with his gente; has finished the divisorio at angastura. used 24 trinquetes, 17 \varnothing mts. fence, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ rolls of 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ wire, 5 rolls of ~~puca~~, 524 varillas. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ days work. - Julian Sanchez had left two troillas of horses at Somotoin & was here on his way back. — 30 —

Sent off the carts to Galchaguí for wire, as Polo Gonzales is not bringing any.

Butchered a novillo of Frakes.

1 cart brought 50 posts from Salado to chacra. Leibarri with his gente working on new chacra fence. Sent gente to ^{brought} puestos to mark tomorrow at ensinada. Fine day but east wind & clouds coming over again; very probably have more damp weather.

— May 1 —

Marked rodos Mistolar today about 2500. Had splendid luck in, best in last 10 years. My idea.. drove cattle very slowly in compact group and no drivers inside, not one escaped. Marked 627 calves of which one died. — Same gente as last time worked. 5 yuntas.

Butchered fat cow at ensinada. —

Dagus did not send any gente to part. We parted all the agno cows with orechano calves out. — Fine day, cloudy and a bit warm at noon. Some varial in has corral at ensinada.

— 2 —

Another hot muggy day. — Marked rodos Tapera about 2500 head. — Parted out first about 80 agno cows with orechano calves. — Had first rate luck in same as yesterday and none escaped. Same gente as yesterday worked & also U. Gomez. — Marked 619 calves. — The 2 carts came back from Galchaguí

May 1900 -

bringing 50 coils wire, spula, etc.

One of the cartmen worked at continuation
of mangas in corral but did not finish it.
Francescos cross plowing - left cattle in for night..

- 3 -

Had on rodeo del medio. about 1500 &
had a good enough luck in; might have
been better but for Baldomero's stupidity, about
gates, etc. Parted out about 50 small calves
first & agnos con cria, and marked 278
calves. Left cattle in for night. - It was
a warm day. Dmt 2 carts up to
Garcia costa Calchaqui with 40 rolls of
9 guanaco wire. Taller sent his gente but
his capataz ~~only~~ ⁴ parted cows & calves into camp.

Had on rodeo Salado ^{again} & parted out cows
& calves to mark. Rodeo about 1000 head,
parted out 123 calves & cows & marked
them in corral; also 11 on rodeo, & 10
tambara calves making a total of 134
marked by noon. Fine day, & nothing
going on in afternoon. - Butchered
a cow. -

- 5 -

Had on rodeo del Istancera (en dos) 3000
and 1000 and parted out 267 calves with
their mothers & marked them in corral.
Practically finished the marcacion. Julian
Sanchez of Union was here, also Anastasio
Aguilar who brought correspondence from
Calchaqui. Fine day & generally had good
luck in this years marcacion, not a very
good marcacion in numbers but quality
very good, left about $\frac{1}{2}$ the mactos for
padres to reselect later on. Vicente Puyal
here to night with trojita of about 100 toritos
11. yrs. from Gacique (Jedops). -

May 6 / 00

Sunday. Puyal & his tropita left..
Had on ruedo del potrero & parted out to put
into south potreros 44 cows DR of Godoy's mark
to fatten to butcher. 7 old cows of our mark,
& 1 rengó novillo. 1 of Godoy's cows we had
already ^{by garcia} butchered, & 1 is supposed to be down
in potrero already making 46, so there are
4 missing. as we had bought 50 from him.
Gomez took animals down to south potrero
also horses which we had working at
marcacion .. Nothing especial going on.-
Fine day. Set fair. Barn.

~~The first up the street at Mistlar (big book)~~
Ox cart went to Calchaqui to bring out trap
which is in from Salta from D'ysdales also a
few stores.. - Marked calves at Mistlar 31 tambores
4 curros. At ~~must~~ Tamario also 34 tambores and
4 . . Micheluds just also passed with
about 20 animals de reculada from other side of
Salado.. Dr Denisio today & his peones also
came from Cacique.. Warm day, cloudy.. -
Fetched in 2 loads of alfa in afternoon.
Gente went on to ~~Lomo~~ Post to work mares there:-

Butchered old cow. Bro't 8 Godoy's mares
from potrero about 65 & marked his colts (16).
He leaves his mares here. to sell
Bro't n alfa, shaked, Paperati cross plowed
in afternoon.. - Nothing going. Lulalia getting
ready to get kid. Looks very much
like if we would have spell of bad weather
as it is cloudy & hot & N.E. wind has
been blowing for a good many days.. -
A. goes to Lomo Poi tomorrow to work among
mares.. - — 11 —

A came back with quite from Lomo Poi
marked the potrillos - 105 total.. -

Put into potrero 546 yequas chucaras and
madrinas. Of which 105 recien marcados,
130 machos, & 311 torados & madrinas.

May 1900

No animals got broke. Luis Martinez & Elias Sediana each took a potro to tame & race July 9. - Gave Don Luis a pataleta de la jura (pecasito o barroso.) Cart had brought cochine in boxes (2) & few stones. - From Loma Loi brought cerda and 13 hides. - Iribarne today finished alambrado of chacra. - Strong N. wind last 3 days & looks like rain. — 12 —

A recurred fence Garcia is making up to his ranchada close to corralito at Ivaldinos old pueblo, just about 2 leagues from south end. Caffrari ^{began} harrowing after 2nd plowing. Got in rest of alfa. Iribarne & 2 ponies went to cut okones for rancho chacrero etc. Butchus novillo of Frakes. - Strong North wind, & looks very stormy. - Not bad sort of a day. The 3 cartmen taking a rest. — 13 —

Sunday. Strong North wind and very warm, tonight south wind set in and looks like a temporal. Getting horse cart ready for Calchaqui in morning. Sent 1 bundle of 12 ciebs, 2 pig, 2 carpinteros skins to Nogues to get tanned.

Also another bundle to H. Macintire to get tanned composed of 5 lion 9 aguara, 8 gato tuga, 2 cuati, 1 gama, 1 quasuncho, 1 small oso. - Report 7 Indians had passed into Micheluds camp. - Had notice of 4 Indians entering camp of Michelud thro camp of N. Dayer. Sent word to Lomotai. — 14. —

Gente were out last night to watch for Indians; no signs. Our carts brought 18 okones from Hartwick's camp. - Francisco went with horse cart to Calchaqui to

Galchaqui bringing out a few odds & ends.
Dominico & his peones cut stakes for
chacraos house. Cafrati harrowing.
Parted out over at Hartnecks camp
about 20 animals m.o less marked 2
calves. Strong N wind looks stormy..

At sunrise, noon from Lomo Poi came
strange word that Jomy had fight
with Indians at estero Medio Luna &
stole a rubio from them evidently Godoy's
man, th 2 cleared their portilla of
diamond fence into Estero Jde where they
were joined by 5 more who evidently
made Jomy clear back to his house, as he
had finished his cartridges (9). Little
after sun rise Gabino reported with fence
cut about 10 squares from his gate, so
immediately A, Esbano, his two rubio peones
& Tiberio got the pistolas (12) & sent word
to Waldino to meet us at portillo to follow
them up. The track seemed about 20 or 25
but very hard to follow. Waldino did not
turn up & did not wait but followed up
till we lost the track at estero jde N.E of
Julians house, found 2 horses left by
them one of J Sanchez tan onto azulejo.
ook a N.N.W direction and at 1.30 P.M
found the track again in front of Chancas
going northerly.. lost it again & went
to the gates estero where we met Waldino
& Alberto & trinch (visco) from punta laguna.
Some Indians had been there but evidently
cleared out.. Slept there and at 11 P.M
saddled up & came back to punta
laguna at 4.50 AM. No use to follow
any further as moon is full Indians
would get too much ahead. Jet home

by 1:30 P.M. Baldomero & 2 peones had brought a trotador mare with 2 crias from other side of Harteneck's camp. 2 carts hauled palms from jaguel we were going to make to house for chacres. Found Jorge Díaz here, went off later. Elias also here & Julian Sanchez here for night. Butchered a novillo (111) fraks. Strong south wind & rather cool.

- 17 -

Sanchez left. Baldomero & 2 peones left to part at Sand Co' estancias costa Salado as they are giving rodos funeral. Liburcio & 3 peones working on Chacres house. Caprati finished harrowing & began cross plowing (2nd time) for alfa. 3 carts hauled palms from Palmar.. Cold morning but no frost yet. wind N.E. wind.

- 18 -

Had news of U Gomez of the roba on night of 14th says they stole 15 horses of ours - J. Sanchez 8 - & have since turned up at Mistolar & 1 left outside of town. Liburcio 13 - 3 left so only could have been 11. Corinto 2 Romulo 1 U Gomez 1 Frakis 2 Baldomero 1

4/5 of Julian & Liburcio left
34 roba so far known -

Gave orders (in copy book) to send 1 peon down to Madero & have the mares pastured down there. - They also left 2 horses down there, & 2 horses & 1 mule at Mistolar. Elias brought up two ponies from paso. butchered 1 in afternoon -

Sunday. Nothing going on.. Murky day and
looks like rain.. Romulo back from troja -
Sent from Elias Espinoza back to Somotoci
to take care of mares at Maderos puestos
with Madero until danger is over..

- 21 -

A reconned up to Vara Calchaqui
Garcia has done 2 leagues 88 posts + 35 + 25 +
+ 41 = 2 leagues 1890 mtros sharp post set up
& 3 leagues - Suspicios tracks of 9 from
estros Los Lijas towards munk (yesterday)
Making mud for Cafuratis house, also put
estankos for cochuria.. The 3 carts brought
rest (?) of posts from Salado which J. Andres
had cut. Nothing else going on. Gacigui
Mariano here for night. -

- 22 -

Elias & A. took canes & tried to find level of
Salado with surrounding camp. At codo
this side of pueblo petroso found the highest
part of camp is 1.55 mt higher than level
of water & lowest in tunado .59 mt higher
than water level. So would have to raise
water up at least 59 cm to make it

flow into camp.. At bend, ^{inside} at big curlepi south of paso found difference between water level & highest part of camp ^{1.22} ~~1.22~~ mt. Iribarne & 4 piones deepened well in forenoon & afternoon worked at Capratis house.. The 3 carts left for Calchaqui in madrugada. Baldomero & 2 piones came back from parting at Land Cos puestos - Micheludos & Billis old camp & Los Muellos & Lucero parted 8 fm Lucero & 3 fm Micheludos camp. Marked 1 calf & 1 that evidently had lost its mark (rabon). - News that Indians had stolen the haceros' horses up near Estos Los Lejas. & left the Indians tracks mentioned yesterday. Cloudy day. The Indians had left it Mistalar at entrado on the 14th

Gomez leaves at end of month. - The fault was evidently he lost his head, as the Indians chased him & he should have sent word. & we could have stopped the Indians on way out with info. - Now Madroño keeps the mares down at his puesto until late & Elías Espinosa helps him. - Iribarne & 3 piones worked at revearing Capratis house, also making mud for crack house. Very cold day strong south wind. Jemin finished

see about their rodeo general.

Julian Sanchez here for night..

Felis Roman from M. Farias Cacique passed
here; says soldiers have 12 horses of ours at
San Bernardo, taken from Indians ^{Indians} ~~bo-leaguas~~
from Jacuru. Had lots of hides(horse) B..
Too wet to harrow..

- 29 -

Weather misty & looked like more rain
so went to work sowing alfalfa.. planted
about half, at rate of 30 kg per square.
The whole piece is 405 mts by 150 mt..

The ground is fine and damp if we get
another shower on top it will sprout
right off.. Butchered wills of Frakes (hides
to be cut.. Machungs came tonight late
with 100. toos. from La California (has not
given his report yet.). Carts went to get lime.

- 30 -

Rec'd the 100 bulls from Machungs cost \$3.77
per head to bring them.. Look rather triste
might be effects of viaje. looks ill..

Had rain nearly all night, slowly drizzled
sort of rain just the very thing for the
alfa.. Paid troopers off.. Cart came with
lime. Settled ac with U. Gomez of Somotoin..

May 31 /

Cloudy day & in evening began raining again; rather a deal of damp weather. - Set up carriage today. -

One of the negro bulls died today. - Several ill, left 6 outside of corral on account of being triste. -

Sent 2 carts to Calchaqui this evening to fetch plow, bordalesas and stores. -

Fine weather for the freshly sown aza.

Gaudelario Ortiz went to take charge of some Poi in place of H. Jones who left today.

June 1 /

Baldomero & quite took bulls over from other side 61 & marked the ones he had so as to take them up to Palmer tomorrow - Ewaldino moved from his priest up to La Barra so as not to disturb the cattle.. Warm day N wind - A goes to Calchaqui tomorrow..

A came back from Calchaqui in trap.. Here nothing going on. Foot & mouth disease not doing cattle much harm excepting to make them thin: just beginning to reach Calchaqui.. Baldomero & quite went to Lomos de la Sierra yesterday & sparked 8 potros & 1 madrina to break, in today.. Eulogio up in Palmer looking after the bulls which had sent up to Tapera Varga.. Weather looks rainy & would do good as water in camp drying up again..
