Alejandro received the alambados from Joe Garcia / Costa Calchaqui / old alambados from Calchaqui to Guampaña) up to Barra Calchaqui 19365 mts. (15000 mts (at 14th + 4265 @ .08 mts). Had some repairs made & it seems pretty good. Baldomero & quite took bulls over from other side 61 & marked the ones he had so as to take them up to Palmer tomorrow - Ewaldino moved from his priest up to La Barra so as not to disturb the cattle.. Warm day N wind - A' goes to Calchaqui tomorrow..

- 29 -

A came back from Calchaqui in trap.. Here nothing going on. Foot & mouth disease not doing cattle much harm excepting to make them thin: just beginning to reach Calchaqui.. Baldomero & quite went to Lomos de la Sierra yesterday & sparked 8 potros & 1 madrina to break, in today.. Eulogio up in Palmer looking after the bulls which had sent up to Tapera Varga.. Weather looks rainy & would do good as water in camp drying up again..

- 30 -

Breaking in potros. Ration day.. Nothing especial going. Caprati breaking up camp 1/2 day with horses & 1/2 day with oxen.. Very warm weather N wind & looks rainy..

July 1 Poisoned hides 106 (+ n. circunc.

Sunday. Butchered old cow. Skinned, cow. Foot & mouth disease spreading rapidly among cattle which are getting thin..

- 2 -

Sent a cow up to Ewaldino at Barra to butcher. Warm hot day N wind but at night south wind set in.. J. Sanchez was here.

Camped 21 fine bulls west of lake in

front of Vargas tapera. Could not find them.
Francisco ^{de} Jiménez cut & arranging a
trozo of Quatrado Blanco for rollo. - Julian
reports Uaga causing malparicion at his
place.. bad look out.

- 3 -

All hands campando fine bulls (2) as
far as punta laguna but they had turned
up at alambrado, & had them put into po-
tros. Bustacio & family left for San Martin..
Mrs Martin came on a visit, & met her at
the paso at the Salado. - Report Uaga dy-
ing out on other side of Salado - last wind
and looks like temporal. Fired patio of piones
quarters for planting trees. Tying rollo for
alfa. - 4 -

Very warm day, quite hot in evening chan-
ged to south again; Want rain again..
Recorred camp. Finished roller; digging
holes for planting trees in front of piones
quarters. Corroban on way & Galchagui
was here..

- 5 -

Butchered an old cow from potros. All
cattle in potros are sick or are getting over
it. In camp sickness also is spreading, &
nearly all of the cattle have it..

Nothing especial going on. Recorred camp.
Turned out to be fine day, but night muggy
again. Gaffarati only plowing $\frac{1}{2}$ day with
horses as all bullocks are sick..

- 6 -

A & gente went up and recorred up in
Palmar; lost 37 of the fine bulls & put them
into potros making 58 there now, and 1
at Julian's. 5 should be in camp..

Robson here today & stays the night; he
had rented the Estacas' estancia with

800 square alfa @ \$3.60 per square..
Planting trees in front of houses quarters..
Wind changed to south looks like temporal.

— 7 —

Reconvened camp south as far as Loma Poi. Cattle sick but don't seem to suffer much; some "malpariando".

Robson left. Mrs Martin still here. Some misty & south east wind but not cold.

— 8 —

Sunday. J. Martin was here for breakfast. Mrs Martin left. Butchered a fat vaca. Last wind fine day. Nothing especial going on..

— 9 —

Feast day. Races. Juan Martin, Curbelo, Pancho, Sislo Martinez, Camilo Vergara, Barga etc etc.!

Patrillo race with J. Martinez, won by Elias Lea. race between As Bayo & Camilos picaos won by As Bayo

race between Rubio & Baldomeros' said won by Rubio. Etc Etc.

Had good breakfast, afterwards drove Pancho Martinez home

— 10 —

Baldomero & family went to Calchaqui in horse cart. - Sent ox cart with palm, canes etc for Tribarne to begin to make school house. Reconvened camp, nothing going on. Warm day, strong N and west wind. Tiburcio domaining. Cafrati making fence around his house. Genie resowing small bits of alfa in old alfalfar.

— 11 —

Brot the catch from Palmer around Baugas tapera to Salado for water as up there

July.

the water has gone out. - Garcia brought telegram from Bill to await him tomorrow, in Calchaqui. - Warm day. Strong N wind. - — 12 —

Baldomero came back from Calchaqui. -- bringing some stores.

A went to Calchaqui to meet William & Bill, and came back tonight. - Foggy morning. Hot day. N wind. - Butchered fat vaca negra

— 13 —

William ill in bed with the influenza. -

Boil up tortilla of Gatiados..

Two cows dead.

A & Bill recovered in pichu or costa Salado. Another hot day & strong north wind.

— 14 —

A. Bill & Balala recovered up Palmar. Had Baldomero repuntar cattle to water at Salado. - Very hot day north wind. - 3 cows dead, skin saved. Go up north tomorrow on about. Elias here. -

— 14 —

Came back from north of Laguna del Perro. On the 15th as soon as arrived at Hualdinos, heard news that about 20 Indians had entered at Morelos & had stolen 4 horses, & came inwards. William, Willie, A, Elias, Machingo, Jinobio went from here, and came back a fat vaca con cuero of Hualdinos at his puesto, and then camped for 1st night in Chilcal N.E of Estero los Lijas. J. Antonio was along, and yesterday Hualdino & Domingo Estam & Domingo Sanchez joined us at other camp Chilcal N of Quebrachal, ^{way} north of Laguna de los Perros. No signs of game, plenty of mosquitos, and rainy weather so came back today. - Had taken carriage as far as Hualdinos

and drove back W. W. & H..

Elias had come further south after leaving camp this morning & found track of arro (about 20) going north quite fresh, but we did not see track so they must have been still in monte. Had had a fine rain here at the Estancia but only as far as the lake, but grand for the camp as weather is warm & grass and alfa will grow immediately. Planting trees around Capratis house.. Caprati breaking up camp again. Peste (llaga) no worse. William still has bad cough.

— 18 —

Nothing going on. Getting ready for William & Willie to go to Calchaqui en route for down south tomorrow. Chasqui came late from Calchaqui.. Very hot N. Wind & looks stormy. Camp improving fast. —

Making' — 19 —

A. came back from Calchaqui taking Bill & Willie in yesterday. Had heavy storm night before last, & hard rain. Roads heavy. Julian Sanchez east came back from Calchaqui bringing 2 bags of flour, 1 bag yuta, soap & kerosene. & left bale of alfa, & 2 bags of maize at Elias. —

Plenty of water in camp now, and weather fresh. Strong south wind all day. —

Peste seems getting over. Indians building school house at Puerto Musters. —

— 21 —

Had on rodeo in potos & forge Barga parted out his animals (9) & 5 of forge Dágers. Bought 1 novillo from him @ 20.- Norman Chandler arrived here from Calchaqui with Pancho Martinez: had sent boy to bring him out but did not meet him on road. —

Hard frost this morning, but splendid day.

Frost will do no harm as ground is wet & camp looks first rate.

- 22 -

Sunday. - Strong north wind. Nothing going Fresh morning. Mail from Calchaqui. —

- 23 -

Butchured novillo brought from Barqa (hide to cut) and also sent cow up to tile cutters up in Palmar. - (2nd animal) Strong north wind last night and fine day. Cofruati breaking up camp. Francisco sowing alfa in bare patches in old alfalfar.

- 24 -

A and Chandler reconvened down as far as Maduros puests - things look all right down there. Camp first rate. Warm day. No wind. Elias here today. got a kid "Cristina". - Baldomero brought a novillo & a fine trout from other side. Luckily as Martin was just taking out the cattle from that petro (Casimiro Tapera). - Skinned cow, 1 hide lost. -

- 25 -

Baldomero & guine went over to Martins & waited at radio of Tapera for Dälper 15 animals of which 1 cow belonged here and the rest to Miguel & Julians. Strong North wind & looks stormy. Camp improving fast. — 26 —

A. and Chandler reconvened up as Baldomeros. Butchured an old cow. - Zenobio cleaning up. Guine working in vegetable garden. Cofruati breaking up camp. Weather changed and strong south wind blowing.

July 27 / 1900

Peones went down to Lomo Poi today to recoger giguada tomorrow. Killed pig in afternoon. Juan ^{1045.} also came with ^{195.} carts & brought hides, cuada, horse hides for amount of ^{6.} \$1246. S.E wind blowing & fresh. Poisoned pigeons in alfalfa. — 28 — Locusts about

Peones brought 8 potros from Lomo Poi to break in also 2 topillas horses.

Nothing especial going on. Making sausages. Cafrate finished breaking up camp at last. whole field plowed up.

Lanazón passing from alambrados of Monte Aguara to Hartnicks camp — Muggy sort of a day. — Locusts about.

— 29 —

Sunday. Had a shower of rain last night and today was an ideal spring day. Cloudy morning & warm. Locusts about. — 30 —

Butchered an old cow. 3 carts went to fetch wood. Muggy day & no tan SE wind. — 31 —

Another muggy day S. wind slight. Hartnicks sent chasqui to see whether we would not sell bullocks. Lent 8 bullocks to Lanazón to haul posts for fencing in Hartnicks camp. Julian Sanchez & Juan Andres passed on way from Calchagui. —

— August 1. —

Another muggy day SE wind — noon. A & Chandler were at Mistral. School house finished with exception of doors. Wiedeman was here for breakfast. Nothing especial going on.

August 29th

Rain last night & strong south wind, and drizzly, muggy all day. - Escobar the new comisario de campo turned up with two police and stops the night. - Butchured a novillo. Sent packmule to Hartnecks to fetch encargos. - mail. - 3

Cleared up in morning after heavy fog. - Carpenter (Quintana) began work making doors for school house. Recorred camp which looks first rate, but not much water had gathered in camp. - 4

South wind which in evening changed to southeast. - Nothing going; put more oreo into potrero. - Splendid weather for camp & cattle are looking well. - 5

Sunday. Horse cart left for Calchaqui to bring out stores. - 4 horses (2. feren.) Hartnecks sent out charqui to offer \$40. for bullocks. - Nothing going on. Cloudy day & coldish. - 6

Butchured a cow DR. - Fine day east wind. Had visit today from Poncho & his wife Martinez Mrs Martinez & small brother & Mrs Melba & 3 children. - Tonight Julian Sanchez & Juan Andres are here. - Darning patros. - 7

Lent horses to Anastasio Aquiar and 3 peones to go over to Martinez to see about novillos. - Recorred camp. - No sun today. & drizzly tonight. Horse cart came from Calchaqui bringing stores. - 8

Strong South wind and cold. & clear. - Had an rodeo in potrero & showed Aquiar the open. there were about 60 & 8 that

August 1900

Lamagon has & some in camp. Told him would sell 50 @ \$50. if William was confirmed. He said it was all right. Butchered a cow. - Nothing going on.

- 9 -

Recovered camp. Put 4 more oxen into patros.

Hard frost⁽⁴⁾ fine day west wind. Lent alfa, & sewing machine to Julian Sanchez. Making preparations for races on 19th. Shot pigeons in patros. (48).

- 10 -

Had on rodeo del Salado about 2600 & parted out 26 old cows & put into patros also 3 oxen, & some of Godoy's cows.

Sent peones to part at Sucero tomorrow. Ramon Vera stops night with a troupe of 22 novillos bought from J. Martin @ \$40. Slight frost (sotney say) & fine warm day & W wind.

- 11 -

A. & Chandler went over to Robsons for rodeo this morning, parted 4 B's & of Micheluds 1 of Faines 1 of Julians. Wilson came back & stops night.

Warm day - Pedro Ortiz & wife came th night to break in patros. Butchered cow.

- 12 -

Sunday. - Went with Wilson across Salado where had sent peones to meet his gente & Robsons, & Martins to drive together cattle, & take them over to Martins.

Ugly morning, cloudy, & afternoon warm & drizzling. Began tying up tamboro novillos to break in.

Aug 13 -

A recorred in morning down as far as Micheluds camp costa Calchaqui, and in afternoon in trap as far as Baldinos' puest. - Nothing going on. Ayo & Romulo began to break in oxen.

Cloudy day & wind looks like rain.

— 14 —

Carpinter came back w/ boat mail. - Heavy fog and fine day. - Baldomero came back from starting out at Martins but 22 animals of which 7 were ours. - rest of Traries & Berlis/puntolaguan. Tuelle sent 2 chaps to see about camp at Fuerte Union. Butchered cow.

— 15 —

Horse cart went to Calchaqui to bring out maize etc. Nothing especial going on. Shot pigeons in afternoon (patrero.) Robson here for night. Also Tuelle brother & brother in law who had been revising camp in Monte Aquara. - Ugly coldish morning. Fine day.

— 16 —

Robson left. J. Martin was here for breakfast. Recorred camp. - Cart came back.

Cloudy day. Drizzled night. -

— 17 —

Had nice little rain last night but not enough to juntar water. Butchered cow DR in morning. - Anastasio Aquiar came and parked out 53 ova for Hartnuck Hnos \$100 @ \$50.00 Locked in corral tonight. Nothing new. Drizzly forenoon but fine afternoon. N.E. wind breast about. -

— 18 —

Muggy morning but fine day. - J. O'conor, W. Yates, Angel Uribe & Cornelio (Porteno) came this forenoon on route to outside outlook out

August 19th.

for camps to settle on. Stop the night.
Escobar & some other chaps turned up
for races tomorrow. Recommended camp.

- 19 -

Sunday. Races with J. Sanchez & cia
(Juan Andrus & Coronado) ran 5 races & won
every race (Los Palmares). O'Connor & party
left for Morelos to inspect Charrua &
Jaquima Socos.

Juan Andrus & J. Sanchez here for night
also Escobar etc. Said Julian Sanchez Rubio
for 5 novillos 3 años arriba.

Very warm muggy north wind day
fine for camp. Trees are quite green.
It leaves for La California.

Sept 4th

Alejandro came back today from La Calif-
ornia bringing two young grey hounds.
Had lots of rain here in his absence, &
the Calchaqui down at pass is just swimming.
Splendid weather for camp. Had given alfalfa
(old) first cut.. Nothing especial had been
going on. Baldomero had been over at Robsons
ranch and brought over animals which Robson
could not take down. & put them into south
pasture. Did not bring the colt & 3 and mares.
Robson is leaving on account of the rain. - Peones
on place are Fr. Genin & wife \$50. Baldomero 36.
his wife cook peones 8.- J. Sanchez 18. Paulino 18.-
Eulogio 18.- Hepolete Sorondona 10. Ponce 18.- peones
Gatino Nunez 20. Baldino 25. J. Sedesma 20.
Damasio Gjido 20.- Hilario Martinez 40. Tomas Nunez
10.^o Madero 20. \$321.⁰⁰ Estanislao Tomador 18-
N. Chandler killing birds. Splendid spring,
never remembered finer. Enough water in camp
to last through summer.

Sept 5 /

Peones filling up in caballeriza which is very muddy.. Put pion to Calchaqui with letter which had come out by mistake.. Making up accounts etc. Splendid day & heavy dew.-

- 6 -

Filling up in presbre still.-

Ideal spring day. just right.

Carts brought wood.

Cart getting ready to go to Calchaqui. —

- 8 -

A had gone yesterday & recorred down as far as south fence & slept at Somo Poi last night. This morning formed the new rodeo at Somo Poi, Elias, Domingo Sanchez, Corriente, Baldomero, Damasio helped. gave very little work. Put 4 of Robson's animals into potrero. South camp full of water, mairss pretty thin.. Butchered novillo of Frakes mark today. — News of indian tracks up at punta laguna today. — Chandler shooting and skinning birds. — Splendid weather. —

- 9 -

Sunday. Another fine spring day east wind. — Man from point of lake (Fritz & smn) came & went down to Somo Poi to begin parting tomorrow. — Cart came from Calchaqui bringing stores & things A had brought from Rosario. —

- 10 -

Had on rodeo general at Somo Poi and Tapira. J. Sanchez, Puntal Palmar, N. Taylor, Michelini gente turned up and parked about 550 altogether (500 Taylor) Rodeo Somo Poi about 570, Tapira 2000. — Isolar here for night. — It was a fine day & not warm at noon — Two more horses sick in potrero. —

Sept 11, 1900.

Had on rodeo Mesiblar, del Medio, & Salado for reculturas. Dajers parted about 150 - 58 - 20 rest about 100 altogether. Fine day and warm -

— 12 — Counternarked 12 calves
for Dajers. 6 cat

Escobar left, gave him bundle of skins for Mrs Hamann who are leaving for Europe. Had on rodeo Istancia about 5500 head in two rodeos. - 17 finished. Dajers took away altogether over 800 head. Micheluds about 50, Sanchez & part of lake 120. Hartnecks 80. Counternarked 2 calves for Michelud, 3 for Dajers. Prison died of pestilence suppose distemper. Buried up today. Strong hot north wind. - Every body left again —

— 13 —

Hot north wind and stormy day, with thunder, drops of rain & in evening S.E. wind. Peones left for puests to part tomorrow at Hartnecks. Drove out in carriage. Cleared up around place.

— 14 —

Rodeo over at Hartnecks. Parted about 350 at north rodeo and 150 south rodeo. Good apart, and cattle in good condition. Baldomero, J Sanchez, Paulino, Lujis, Elias Ledum, Rojelio, J Ledesma, H. Martinez, Pascho, Rómulo & other amazaderos de buyes worked. Sold 12 creollo bulls to Hartnecks @ \$50. (that is if they can corral them) tomorrow will counter-mark them. Stormy day with some rain & plenty of mosquitos. Mail came by Hartnecks. Butchered cow.

— 15 —

Domingo L. & Paulino counternarked the 12 bulls for Hartnecks. Marked 18 calves at puests of recultura cattle (from Hartnecks). Temporalish sort of morning, drizzly & in

afternoon plenty of mosquitos. - Carpenter (Guitaro) left. had paid him at rate of \$1.00 per day. - Nothing particular going on.

- 16 -

Sunday. A, & Chandler drove up to Encalduros of Jose Matheus; horses rather fresh. Fine day. SE wind, tremendous dew in morning..

- 17 -

Went over to rodeo at P Sanchez & parted out 7 animals of ours B. also parted out 29 novillos from Sanchez, partly in trade & rest @ 25.^c also brought 1 from Sabino @ 20 - afterwards put in rodeo in potrero & parted out the remainder 23 5 acre (4 of Cowolans) making 58 animals for truck which we begin to make tomorrow. F. Jente went to Calchaqui with horse cart to bring out some stones. Jente came together brought to make truck. also gentle of Nicolas Dager for parting. Hot day NE wind & looks like rain..

- 18 -

Had on rodeo up at point of Palmar Lake⁽¹⁵⁰⁰⁾ and parted out ^{about} 136 novillos and afterwards had on rodeo del Salado about 400 and parted out 30 making about 227. - 10 men worked on their own horses and 1 man in afternoon. - Hot sultry day with strong north wind. also had parted 2 more novillos of J. Sanchez. Nicolas Dager quite parted again 12 animals. Looks very stormy --

- 19 -

Had on rodeo Estancia about 35.00 head and parted 227 novillos, afterwards had on rodeo del Medio and parted 107. - 1 more man than yesterday worked.

Very hot day & strong N. wind. - Felis from Miguel Fraies (Cacique) here today, gave him vale \$150.- Horse cart came back

from Calchaqui today. - Mail came.

- 20 -

Had on video dela tapera and parted about 1500
100 novillos & then video del Mistolar and
parted 192 and 1 lame ox and 5 cencerro
novillos from Mistolar Tambios - 867 mas/minus.
Strong N wind 92° looks very stormy -
Nicolas Sayas quite partied few -

- 21 -

Had on video dela Soma about 800 head
& parted out 34 novillos, & video del Potrero Sud
and parted out 36 mostly tambia novillos
& delivered them to troop which marched
on towards Madero. Counted them 942 and
5 vaguillas (re dianos) pretty good trap
& should get down by the 5th. 12 min stay
going. - 10 bueyes redomones @ 35. - 3 novillos ^{Almacelado} Baldomero
@ 30.. 1 novillo Corralan 25 - 5 of S. Moreira 30. -
31 of J. Sanchez @ 25. - 24 simuleros @ 35. - raza
macha 30.. 5 vag. @ 10. 905 novillos B @ 30 -
total 977 - \$29,580. Last night suddenly strong
South wind arose & got quite cold & cloudy today..
Drove down to Soma & back with trap. -

- 22 -

Hard South wind blowing all night, &
a dash of rain not enough to lay the dust..
Cool windy day. Baldomero came back
from La Soma Poi with troupe of horses
reports troupe having passed good night..
Fixed up mowing machine.
Butchined cow. Put new simuleros (12) into
potrero. - 23 -

Sunday. Nothing extra going on.. Drizzly
forenoon. A and Chaudler were over at Hart-
enecks in trap. Sheep at Mistolar lost..

Sept 24 /

Men recovered camp. Cow Cloudy S. wind
Capivari planting maize for chacllos..
Chandler packing his bird skins up
shot 142 birds, 97 skinned, 61 varieties

— 25 —

Ran on radio del potrero and parted out
the bulls from down south, the simurros &
other animals that did not belong in potrero.
Bulls not looking very bright. - Discovered
the simurros & broke one. - Butchered a cow. -
A & Chandler were up at J. Sanchez to see about
the certificates for his novillos which the comisario
would not dispatch. No stops here the night. -
Fine day. Cutting newalfa. - 1st time. A &
Chandler go to Calchaqui tomorrow as the latter
leaves for Tucumán.

— 28 —

A. came back from Calchaqui. Got quia for
novillos except for 10 of Soothards mark for
which certificate could not be dispatched. -
England accounts in Calchaqui. Baldomero
here had entered 3 bulls from other side of fence
Costa Calchaqui. - also parted at Hartenbeck's
yesterday 32 animals. - Brought in alfa today.
Fine warm weather, another fine bull dead
in camp. — 29 —

A. and Baldomero were up at Palmer
counting the tiles/tejas de palma this morning.
Jru Manuel 544 de cuenta. -

Santos 220. . .

Martin y S. Istana 390.?

J. Villegas y Cia 750 - 8 wanting yet.

1904 total act de 110. -

Tirucio open brought up potros which had
escaped from potrero. -

Butchered cow in afternoon. -

J. Benavidez here tonight. -

Neg strong but N wind 90°. -

Sept 30/00

Sunday. Arranged accounts with the Indians who were cutting tiyas; all finished. Fearful hot day '99. strong N wind in forenoon. Stormy night.

— Oct. 31 —

Had a tormento last night but little rain, but a fine fresh day, & cloudy. Señalarde & castrated lambs at pueblos Huistlar. J Sanchez was here, also Ramon Vera on way over to Martins.

— 2 —

Had on Palmar rodeo about 1200 head. J Sanchez parted his catch & some of S Alburro's about 300 head. We parted out 59 calves & marked them; also 15 calves of Estancia farm-heras afterwards. It was a fine muggy day; no sun, looks rainy.

Also parted out 6 pinuchos more & discarded them one side —

— 3 —

Had on rodeo Estancia about 1200 head, & parted out 51 calves & marked them. J Sanchez also parted about 100 animals. Had cattle on in Petruco for M Fraire's gente who parted out 35 animals, leaving 5 novillos for sale. Susto Martinez was here & gone ahead. Another muggy day, & this evening a tremendous hailstorm. camp north of house covered with hail. Horses all cleared out on account of storm.

— 4 —

Found horses late this morning. Peones had put on rodeo del Medio, but let go again. Had on rodeo del Salado in afternoon, but no organo calves. Señalduio sent 12 tambores cattle down from his pueblos and put them into petruco. Splendid fresh day. Fixing up around place.. fence in yard, & netting door.
