

Mr & Mrs Hartenack and Don Pancho were here in afternoon on a visit. J. Martin here for the night. Baldomero and gente down at Somotai to work rodeos tomorrow.

April 1 - 1901

Butchered cow. Cloudy day. E. wind and looks like rain. J. Martin here. The men paraded rodeo in Spetrus & rodeo de la Soma? I did not go down. --

- 2 -

Road on rodeo generales, Tapera about 1200, Mistlar 1800. Medio 5500, Estancia 1600. Dayers, Sanchez, Micheluds, Monteaguera people parting. Splendid day for work. Not many agenos. --

- 3 -

Road on rodeo Palmar 3500, afterwards Salado 1800, and potrero. Sanchez parted about 200 de marca, J. other side of Salado 14, Hartenack's 14 - & Nicolas Dayer about 100 Michelud '0 total about 338 animals. Drizzly sort of day, & good for camp. J. Martin here still.

- 4 -

Good Thursday. feast day. Butchered cow. Put in² young horses in cart. Martin left. Foggy morning. Splendid day.

- 5 -

Good Friday. Weather in morning looked threatening but in afternoon cleared off and quite cool. Nothing going on.

- 6 -

Put the finishing touches on corral for marcacion. A was down at Somotai Escobar the comisario Campo had been rondaring the south alambrado since Monday (1st) and left again today. It was a splendid day.

April 7 - 1901 -

Sunday. Butchered cow. Gente coming to-
gether for marcacion. Nothing going on.

Fine day. S wind, weather looks settled
but barometer is still low. - Salado rising.

- 8 -

Began marcacion. - Rodeo Palmar about
2000 head (trds to que piso) had good lock in ^{9.30 am.}
& marked 312 calves by 1.30 P.M. Left them
locked in and paraded rodeo estancia
about 1200 head.. good lock in also. -
Parted out lots of small calves with their
mothers into camp. - Elias, Arnulfo, Paulino,
Zacharria, Canuta, Tomingo, Hilario boy,
Sish-Martinez & 3 peons, J. Sanchez & 2 peons,
Aristobulo, Roque - Juadino, J. Gonzalez,
Benancio, worked. Baldimero was drunk in
areado Palmar Rodeo so had row & he left
looking for work. - It was a pleasant mor-
ning but warm afternoon. Looks like a
very poor marcacion. -

- 9 -

Left out cattle (Palmar rodeo) and sighted
them on old ~~Estancia~~ rodeo, and then
marked ^{Estancia} ~~Palmar~~ rodeo. 302. In morning
early had paraded rodeo Salado about 1500
and locked them in after marking Estan-
cia rodeo; pretty good lock in. ^{11 am.}
Took estancia rodeo then out to old rodeo
and at 2 P.M. began marking Salado
rodeo 3.30. finished 4.45 P.M.. Left
them locked in.. Gente left to sleep at
puerto to recajar tomorrow. - Same gente
as yesterday worked. Surely Hughes also
here for night. - Warm day, North wind.

- 10 -

Left out Salado rodeo and took it to its
rodeo, and then went to rodeo del Medio
about 2500 head trds to que piso; Parted out

Apr. 1901

about 200 cows with small calves, and
locked the rest in: a pretty good lock in
and marked 472 calves by 2.30 P.M..

Broke one. In evening left them out. —

J. Sanchez, & Lomta & son left in evening.

Sisk still here helping.. Warm day. dust
& north wind..

— 11 —

Had on radio Michlar about 2500 head,
& had a slow but good lock in by 9 am.
and marked 517 calves by 2.30 P.M.

Few small calves. Francisco took horse
cart down to ensenada with water etc..

Warm day N.E. wind.. Butchered cow
down there.. Day in chicar died today..

Fence broke by J. Sanchez, cattle which some
got into camp. Same gente as before working
5 juntas. Some paisanos turned up.

— 12 —

Had on radio Tapira about 1800 head and
had in good lock in by 8.45 am.

Marked 331 by 12.30 P.M.. Butchered cow..

Same gente as before worked..

Baldemero last night brot mail..

It was a very hot day, strong N wind &
plenty of dust in ensenada..

Hartinecks took rollos for alfa..

Broke one fine calf but very likely will
live. —

— 13 —

Marked at Lomo Poi this forenoon.

Had on radio about 500 and marked
127, afterwards marked 30 tambores..

Finished by 11 am. and discharged
the 6 men "por dia". Butchered cow

down there.. Strong south wind came up
in morning and cloudy stormy day but
no rain.. Cart from Las Cañas came

Apr - 1901 -

to take Baldomero and family away. Gave
trodilla to Eulalia as she has been raised
here & 'faca care', but no certificate so she
can not sell or lend away horse.

— 14 —

Sunday. Baldomero and family left for
Las Cañas.

Gloomy day, but in afternoon cleared up.
Butchered cow. Nothing going on

— 15 —

Elías and gente went over to marca-
cion at Julian Sanchez; lots of cattle
of his had entered the scrub here again
at end of fence in lake.

Juan Fillon was here at breakfast, from
Pozomariano where he proposes to rent a
legua of camp. None of our animals
at J. Sanchez rodeo. Waldino took res.
Fine day. N.E. wind.

Cart went to Calchaqui for stores.

— 16 —

Reconnoered camp this forenoon; found 2
dead marked calves.

In afternoon marked 32 tambores calves &
carrero. Cart came back from Calchaqui
with stores, mail.

Fine day N.E. wind. Making gate for
puerto. Johnnie telegraphs a son was born
on the 14th. Easter Sunday.

— 17 —

Marked in potrero this morning a rodeo
49 calves of Frakes, 40 of B and 7 of Elías
Felis & Baldomero. Found a dead vaquilla
of Lombardo looked like if it had been
dissected. It was a pleasant day N.E.
wind & looks like if it were veering towards
rain.

Apr 18 / 1901

Had slight drizzle in morning, and afterwards strong south wind..

Marked 31 tambura calves at Mishlar of which 19 were machos (1 left as toro) 12 hembras and 2 cerreros. also 1 potrillo

Afterwards marked 34 tambura calves at Paso Balchagui of which 11 were capared 3 para toros 4 too small - 16 hembras and 5 cerrero calves.

Gente from there went to La Loma Pri to work tomorrow.

Aviso rodio general at Campo Union
Cia de Zucas on 20th

— 19 —

Had on rodio in potrero sud and parted out the calves with mothers ^(old cows and Q) mostly and marked 121 cerreros and 4 Tamburos 125..

Of these 28 were of Q cows, 2 of Robson, 1 of Villalba, 2 guachos, 2 large oxchans and 92 B old cows to butcher and bad colour.. The gente leave Somolai to part at Union tomorrow. — Francisco took machim over to Hartenucks to cut alfa.. ~~but~~

1st frost & fine day wind variable. 3 agenos mancarones turned up in camp today Rosillo R Colorado ~~to~~ ^{San Diego Monte Negro} Luis Salu who they belong to. 1 Butchered cow.

— 20 —

I was over at Potrero Union (Cia de Zucas) but they were only giving rodio general and not marking yet. Cloudy morning and strong south wind afterwards & Clear. Francisco back from Hartenucks and brought many ^{des} grainers along (borrowed) .. Nothing going on here as no one is here. except Caballero, Pescadero, & Domador..

Apr. 21 - 1901. -

Sunday. - Nothing going on. Sente not back yet from aparte at Cia. de Tierras. -

Roque and family came in afternoon. he enters as mensual and his wife as cook. Julian Sanchez passed on way to Calchaqui as his mother is very ill. - South wind, cold and cloudy. - Put outside of gate 21 animals of J. Sanchez. -

— 22 —

No signs of the apartadores yet, expect they have gone down as far as Las Conchas parting in Sand Cia's estancias. -

Accorried as far as Waldinas. Roque as far as gate esta Calchaqui. -

Fine day. Francisco disgrained some maiz in machine which Sista Martinez had lent. Fine day, no especial wind. -

— 23 —

Elias came back from reculuta, parted at Union. Lucero, Playa fde, Aguara fde and brought 25 animals of Robsons and 1 of ours. - Butchered a cow in afternoon. -

Sent word to J. Sanchez that we parar rodeo tomorrow. North wind, warmish day. - Recorried camp. -

— 24 —

Had on rodeo Palmar in morning, and ³⁰⁰⁰Lonely Hughes (for J. Sanchez) parted out about 400 animals; we parted out about 70 cows with orechano calves, and afterwards parted rodeo Salado ¹²⁰⁰, and Sanchez parted about 100 and we about 30 calves. Marked them afterwards 101 calves. - Elias had a rodado & got lame. - North wind warmish day. a Comet appeared before daybreak on east horizon. -

Apr 25 / 1901

Had on rodeo del Medio first and then Estancia afterwards. Sanchez gentle parted about 100 animals, and we parted 64 calves & marked them in corral. -

Sanchez gentile have their cattle here on pastures about 600 head. - Noticia that Machingo has arrived with tropita toros at La Soma Pai from La California. - Fine day south wind and cool. -

— 26 —

Had on rodeo Tapura and afterwards Mistolar. Parted out 64 calves and marked 63 in ensenada the 64th got broke & not marked. J. Sanchez and gentile parted about \$5. --- Cart had gone down to ensenada with water, marks, etc. - Sanchez left with his aparte over 600. - It was a cold morning, but pleasant warm day. - Seca and looks like if it is going to continue, lucky the Salado has some water and most of the deep esteros. -

— 27 —

Had on rodeo de la Soma this morning and parted & marked 47 calves - afterwards had on Tamboras again and marked 3 cerreros & 5 Tamboras total 55. Left most machos for toros (A. venta) Saw the bulls (100 & 3 cows) which Machingo brought. they are thinish mostly but look healthy. Leave them this side of fence 72 are inoculated and 28 uninoculated. - Jorge Dayer here for night. - Sanchez brother & Monk Negro & boy passed here in evening. - Gentile stopped at Sonora Pai & were going to Amalar curders at Madero this afternoon. - Pleasant day south wind. cold morning.

Apr 29 - 1901

A. came back from Somotzi this evening. Yesterday had recovered all the yeguada in the South potrero and parted all the agenos out and left them this side of the alambrado and put our mares in corral and marked the colts and

157. Counted them afterwards.
Tiburcio had parted 21 petros ^{with} Madrid
to break in. and then drove the
yeguada to Los Mochis:-

560 yeguas Chúcaras

14 " manas.-

9 " Robson. -

91 horses with madonnas.

Total 674 put into Los Molles camp. Only gave cuenta of 672 to Collins. In potrero left tropilla 6 mules, & tropilla redomones 19.

Elias also puts some of his own animals in. - Killed one old mare for Lonja. -

A was over at Moyes and saw Collins.
Coldish weather yesterday but today
warm again. - J. Varga brought mail
today. - Butchered cow today. -

30

Genk came back from Sono Poi at noon
bringing the tropilla of Calvarados and
Polon which got from one tropilla, and
the potros of Teburcio 21 including madrina
which he took to Salado potrero. -

Pamigno Luna came tonight from Cacique with troika of 24 animals from In Train for Hartinick's. - Warm day strong north wind. - gave munnuals each \$10. & a few days freedom from work as they had worked so well at marcacion. -

May 1 - 1901

Nothing going on here at estancia as most of the peones are off on a paseo. - Disgrained some maize in afternoon - North wind warm day. - A. off to Calchaqui tomorrow. -

- 4 -

A. came back from Calchaqui this evening. - Had trap fixed, balancin made etc. - Elias had parted all the machaje out from our tambores⁴³ at Paso Calchaqui also his own³⁷ & put into Potrero South. - Marked 51 of his own calves. Getting awfully dry and Salado falling again. - Nothing particular going on -

- 5 -

Sunday. - Strong north wind and tormentish. Very likely have a big rain. - Comet appears again last few nights on west side about dark with tail turned up & south westerly. - Waldino was here; says indians have entered up by M. Durans & coming southerly 7 or 8. A. was over at Julian's who says Verde people are going to make tajamar. - 6 - at Salado. -

This morning boy from Lomo Poi came and said indians had cut fence last night, going in but did not steal anything. Shortly afterwards Machungo^{10.20 am.} turned up from Vargas Union potrero, saying 15 indians after sunrise drove off Vargas horses, chasing the horn Rogelio. - After breakfast Pancho el riego came from Lomo Poi saying indians (15) at madrugada killed the Paraguayo Francisco (hunter who was encamped at old puente) & wounded a boy (young junco). Collins also had sent word saying indians (2) had been seen in Plaza 4^{to} potrero catching horses in morning early, 2 also in Lucero, & Machungo saw 2 in Punta month Union potrero. Sent Uris & 2 peones down to Muelles to vigilar jiquas. - Hilario Martinez was here in morning early

on way to Calchaqui but only got as far as Hartman when the news reached him & came back to Lomo Poi. Very hot 90° north wind. Saca. Salado getting low. Sent rifle to Julian who is going to riglar Salado tonight. -

- 7 -

Boad sent Roque over to Vargas to find out about the Indians. They got away yesterday morning passing through Martins & La Verde camp; taking 2 tropillos from Vargas camp, horses & mares from different owners in Martins camp, 1 tropilla from Verde camp. No one followed them up.

Elias & quite came back from Moyes where there was no novedad in our jiguada. It seems 17 Indians had entered south potreros & came out through gate, and painted with other ones who had stolen a tropilla from S. Micheludo corral & also from Cia Kemmerich, & passed over Salado in front of Lomo Poi, & coasted up and killed the hunter. The boy is still very bad from wound. Strong stormy south wind which likely will blow away all rain again. - Miguel Varga had rondado camp last night. -

- 8 -

Fine day. Sent the 2 & 4 carts to Calchaqui to get fixed and to bring out durmientes. Horse cart (Caferata) came back from Calchaqui. No more news of the hunter. - 6

- 9 -

Temperamental sort of day, and drizzle a bit in afternoon. - Jacobo & Lopez came at noon from Calchaqui via Lomo Poi where had gone to make summary on death of Paraguayo Francisco - by Indians, they stop the night. - Butchered cow. -

May 10 - 1901 -

Escobar & Lopez went to Calchaqui. -

A went over to marcacion petro Union
Cia de Tierras, - and stopped night over
at Martins. Misty morning & cold day
with strong south wind.

11

Hard frost. Nothing going on particular
Fine day. -

12

Sunday. A was down at Somotui -
the wounded boy (Jurea) was taken away
yesterday. - Hilario Martinez leaves
today as his wife is afraid to come out. -
North wind, & cloudy coldish. -

13

Cloudy & warm day. Funny weather as it
does not rain, & barometer does not fall.
A was up Salado to Verde camp be-
yond Corvolan's where they had made a
tajamar. The Salado is stopped and
on this side it is "cortandose". -

Butchered a lame novillo in afternoon. -
Report of 3 indians having been caught
at Cacique. -

14

Warm day. N. W. wind and cloudy. -

A was over at Harteneck's camp to
look at their two new norias. - Nothing
going on. Elias deting as caballeriza
as sacked old man. Carts still in Cal-
chaqui getting fixed.

15

Warm heavy day. N. W. wind. - cloudy. -

Racion day. -

From Paso Calchaqui report Elias sheep taken
by N. Tayors shepherd & wont give them up.

Elias went there & to Somotui. -

Mail came. -

- 16 -

Warm day N wind and murky. -
Alberto Huber was here for breakfast. Says
very dry up there. A was up at Inwaldinos. -
Elias brought two very thin bulls up from Somo
Poi & put them in asfufar. -
The two carts came back from Calchaqui, filed
but the ¹⁶chumientos were not found. -

- 17 -

Another warm day N wind. -
J. Sanchez was here, had come from Caeique
bringing a blanco horse which soldiers
had took from indians. - Made arrange-
ment to group and open tajamar of La
Verde. - Pancho Martinez here for night. -
Recovered camp. -

- 18 -

Horse cart 4 in hand for first time went to
Calchaqui to bring out stores. -
A and 3 men with Elias went up to tajamar
La Verde people had made & made a ditch
though it so that water passes through as
Salado nearly dry. Corrolan and son also
helped. As were getting finished up turned
Carlos Castillo manager of La Verde; told
him he could not stop the water and said
he should make arrangements with Sana Co
and make a tajamar a la vara and up
this way if necessary. - Warm day E wind
new moon and looks dry. -

- 19 -

Sunday. Butchered a fat cow. -
Horse cart came from Calchaqui bringing
stores. Francisco rather drunk. -
J. also turned up with 2 carts to buy & sell
goods. - Fine day East wind. -

Mar
- Apr 20 - 1901 -

The two carts went up Palmar to fetch
tejas. - Elias recovered Salado. - Very low. -
Strong N.E. wind and looks rainy. - Looking
for a place to make jaguel up in Palmar. -

- 21 -

Sent Elias down to Lomolai to look
after the new bulls brought up two.

A was up in Palmar with Francisco
and Capurata & tried for water. Found
good water on albardén S E of Waldim
Tapura. Carts brought 120 tejás. Fearful
day strong N wind & hot, & tonight chang-
ed to south. -

- 22 -

A went over to Hartenucks and to new
noria there. saw Cabañas for him to come
and make jaguel in Palmar. price to be
arranged afterward. Met Renner & compan-
ion & came over together and stops the night.
Looks rainy or rather like a temporal.

Carts went to fetch leña. Sent Zipriano to
Lomolai to be with Corriente for a bit. -

- 23 -

Muggy, cloudy, misty day. Thundering in
morning. Renner left in morning. Took
Rubio chico on trial @ 100. - ^{a very weak} Butchered an
old cow. - Nothing going on. -

- 24 -

Cleared up in morning and fine
day. N.E. wind & a bit cloudy yet. -
Men recovered camp. Nothing new. -
Over hauling camping out outfit. -
A goes to Calchaqui tomorrow.

May 28/1901

A came back from Calchagui tonight bringing Kingland who came today from La California, Fiestas in Calchagui and a baile at Reneros. - Hauled two loads of sleepers up to new well at Palmar for calya; getting ready for Cabanas who is going to dig it in about a fortnight. - News of Indians in Michellud's camp. - Hot weather last few days and today strong south wind & cloudy and looks rainy. - 29 -

Had fine rain last night, slow but soaking but not enough to jump water in esteros. - Temporalish sort of day. Recorred potrero Salado, cattle looking thin there. Making straps etc. -

- 30 -

Slight frost this morning but a beautiful day; wind changed to N.E. - Carts hauled durmientes to well up in Palmar. - Ration day. Nothing new in camp

^{June}
- May, -

A and Kingland recorred down as far as Madero's puesto & Las Moyas and slept at Lomolvi. Mares and sheep looking all right. Camp also improved since last rain. - Carts went to Calchagui yesterday to bring out durmientes etc. -

Cabanna to Progreso was here today & made agreement with him to dig the jaquet up at Palmar viz: copy book. - N. wind fine weather. But part of old afo. in afternoon. Butchered cow yesterday. Nothing new in camp. -

June.

May 2 - 1901

Sunday. Fine warm day. Wind stops raining again. Nothing going on.

Arkingland were up at Puerto Salmar. Mail from Calchaqui. Cattle looking well.

— 3 —

Carts came this afternoon bringing 22 durmientes; lost 3 oxen.

A and Kingland were over at Harberucks for breakfast. Strong N wind and warm.

— 4 —

Carts left again for Calchaqui to bring more durmientes.

Warm day and strong N wind.

Dionisio Godoy here for night on way to Cacique.

— 5 —

Butchered cow.

Went with Godoy to potrero where he marked 2 colts. He left after breakfast for Cacique.

Reconvered camp. Nothing new.

— 6 —

2 wheeled ~~or~~ cart went to La Loma for fire wood etc.

Elias y Kingland went to La Loma for rodeo tomorrow.

Finished getting in alfalfa cut on the 1st. Hot day. N wind.

— 7 —

A was over at Cabanas where he is digging a well at La Loma Harberucks, and afterwards at Guorino Parera.

2 men of alimans hire to take away his 2 oxen. Elias brought up from lower potrero 6 cows & novillo for consuma, & 5 oxen. Warm day N wind.

June 8 - 1901

Cart came in morning and in afternoon; broke one ox which died (Panchito).

They brought 21 durmientes. Kingsland recovered Calchaqui up to Waldino's. Fine warm day and South wind again, looks like a sea. Agos to Calchaqui tomorrow.

— 10. —

A came back from Calchaqui with Todd. The 2 carts took durmientes to well at Palmar today yesterday and today went to Calchaqui to bring out pine timber & tar for well. Weather turned cool again and no rain. Camp all right. Nothing new. John ^{Martin} ~~Isabel~~ was here today.

— 11 —

Fine day. E wind, morning a bit overcast. Kingsland, Elias, & I went down to Los Moyes to get horses for Agos & Todd's hunt. Getting ready to go out.

— 12 —

Cloudy fine day. E wind. Elias & Kingsland came from Moyes bringing 30 horses including madrina & salt. (mancazones to take outside.)

Report mares & horses getting thin.

Nothing going on. ^{Francisco with horse cart brot.} well diggers from Guampita to dig well in Palmar.

13 - Carts came from Calchaqui bringing pine trunks & alquitran.

Dreizzly sort of a day. S wind & coldish.

Butchered a big novillo negro descomado of Villalbas mark. Elias left in afternoon with Roque Suarez & Tomas Almada taking the horses ^{26 - 24 horses} to Arenales (Reconquista) and 3 packmules for Todd & Agos hunt. Loaded carts for Palmar, sleepers, 1 1/2 inch pine, ^{14 inch} alquitran. - 14. chief of police came.

Fine day. S.E. Wind

Chaldirio took 1 cow from Salado potrero for consumo. Don Agos & M. Todd left for Reconquista. Recovered part

of Calchagui North part. also Recor-
ered Salado North part. Conquite
came from La Loma pue^{to} & sent
cart with 17 vacuno skins ^{brought in} also 20
vacios. Camba' came for Views. Recor-
reinde. North side of camp from Estancia
up to Palmas also part of South side
sent cart with pemos & materials
to Well at Palmas. Chief of police
left. Salado beginning to Rise

— 16 — (Sunday)

South Wind in the morning also slight
drizzle until about 9 o'clock Wind
changed to North. rather warm. Recor-
ered Salado & south of house ^{in the afternoon} 40 skins
brought in. Eubaldino came for salt.
Don Francisco clearing away old fence
of palmas in front of dining room. recor-
ered part of camp North of house in the
morning. Two pemos cutting Monte in
Hartnicks camp passed through the camp
from the other side of South potrero. Cart
from La Loma pue^{to} left with rations &
Salado Rising

— 17 —
South Wind. Misty until 10 o'clock & fine
afternoon Kinpland recovered South
potrero & slept at La Loma pue^{to}. Hartnicks
parted 20 buyes from S Potrero ^(origuno) leaving 11.
Skinned 1 Suro North West of house. Recorried
North of house by palmas. Killed for
Consumo 1 cow. Mora. B. from Salado
potrero. Trap from station arrived in
the afternoon. rations taken (18 kilos) meat
to pozeros.

— 18 — Salado Rising
Corquite from La Loma pue^{to} went to
La Inuelle to pass mares the other side
of Anoyo. Towards monte. recovered Camp
from La Loma pue^{to} to Estancia. Sheep in
good Health. Lambs getting on fine.
Mensuals recovered fence ^{costa} Calch-
agui & fixed Sanyon a bit

recomiendo North of house. 1 skin lost
in front of Encanada. Joria digger
came this evening 1 tenere died North
of house. Look off. skin (^{Laure} ~~Laure~~ ^{Laure} ~~Laure~~) puesteros of
La Loma que came for Nations (Joria).

~~Laure~~ ~~Laure~~ passed 1 Bull from North of house
in alfalfa. fixing ^{new} fence in front of dining
room - 19 - Salado stopped

fine day. Slight North Wind

Look a small novillo out of well having
falling in during the night, (alive) Don
Paucho. Hartweck's Encargado came joining
to Juan Martins. Recovered Palmer. Tzoros
began digging well at Palmer. Puestero
of Salado poteros news (all well). Peru from
Lucero came for Vicos. 20 skins brought
in Recomendado North of Salado & South of
Estancia house. finished fence in front of
dining room. Tzoros Look. Sains horse & Tordillo
also Look meat. (10 kilos). Chaque from
Calchagui came. 20 - Salado falling

fine day. North Wind slight

skinned ^{señalado} ~~señalado~~ (Costa Salado) sent trap
to Calchagui to fetch buyer of Bullo
Salado falling. Puesteros of Salado
poteros took 4 posts & some hay in
two wheeled cart also brought 5 cows
skins B & 1 orejano skin (Tenere). Re-
covered Salado & South of Estancia
also North of Estancia. Killed for
consumo from Salado poteros 1 oreja
naya cow B. puesteros from Yustlas
came. No news in camp. Don Paucho
Returned on his way to Hartweck's.
No news in Salado poteros. digging
well in Palmer 21 -

fine day. Slight north wind

Brought in two skins 1 Bull oreja
