 are doing nicely. Tomas still sick {Rheumatism}

SÁBADO 4 SATURDAY

Warmer. cloudy. easterly wind. shifting at times to north. Elias delivered some of J Sanchez's cattle to his profers for Butcherd stock. out of Patro Salado: Cart's brought two ^{with} loads of wood from Hartneck's. Coferat got beef stores etc. Regulated with B Nunez as I don't need him any longer. Spent in three cows tambores second camp. Butcherd Cow B

DOMINGO 5 SUNDAY

Warm day. very light north wind. Barometer {variable}
 Elias and gente went over to Hartneck's this afternoon for rocks tomorrow. I wrote to Don Alfredo. F Benin was here today says he will not come here after meat. However he took 12 1/2 kilos home with him. I am all alone again very triste? would be glad to see ^{even} a boy that could talk english

LÚNES 6 MONDAY

Began raining just at daylight and continued very slowly untill 9 a.m. {3 1/2 millimetres} wind East changing in afternoon to South Tomas Vergara and two castramen began work on corral at Mistolar. Coferat cut a little hay. J Vergara has lots of company tonight. {all told 16?} There is also one Indian here for the night. following one that passed here last week to recover stolen horse {so he says} Two women five men and one boy passed here on horses this afternoon say they are going to Verde camp

MÁRTEZ 7 TUESDAY

A very little rain early .023^{mm} Cald South wind. Cloudy
I went down to Mistolar and from there to Harteneck.
Sent letter to Don Alfredo also sent chasque after
twine to Calchaqui. Peon from Loma here after cart
to haul wood. F. Benin sent his boy here after meat
today. Surprising what hunger will do: Butchered cow B

Hard frost, clear day, light easterly wind
Elias and gente got back from Harteneck: with 12
animals {vacunos} put 1 orejano in potrero Salado also
put 14 of Sanchez: in same potrero: Recovered camp

Sent Balbuena to advise Sanchez to come to potrero tomorrow
after his cattle. Barometre {En tiempo?}
Tomas and gente working at corral at Mistolar

I wrote the above before going over to Guevra.

 and castated (collected) colts. Light rain and some hail from
 1 to 3 P.M. fell 2 mit after which cool south wind sprang up

Cool south wind all day. Threatening rain. Leopilo Suarez brought
 letter from Don Alfredo. Elias went into town with letter
 for Don Alfredo. Cafarati finished stening the chakra
 recovered camp with out finishing anything of importance
 Mensuales went down to Lima to give rocks in south
 potrero to Company de Tierras Tomorrow. Nothing doing.

 South afterwards some cooler. Cafarate planting man
 I recovered camp in forenoon. Nothing in evening
 Machingo got back with twine & stones etc. {No letters}

Very warm day 35° SÁBADO 18 SATURDAY North wind
 Went down to Loma. where Elias was castrating colts yesterday and today he castrated 67
 also gave robes Patro Sud to eis de Lomas they took 52 animals home
 Cafarate Planting man
 Butcherd cow B.

Another very warm day 38°. North wind
I went down to Puerto J. Madero in trap. Taking
twine shears and so forth. passed the night at
Gama where we had a good shower of rain
I find they had were at Estancia

I came back from Gama. and went down to Mistolar
and started the shearing there. F. Benin came here today
with accounts of Indians having stolen all the horses of
A Huber. Saturday night leaving him only one macovone
Elias and quite few up horn on Jaquel Estancia
also a bebidó at small well. and Butcherd cow B
James and one few working at corral mistolar

Coparate planting maize.
Domingo Lirivarne came here last night and kept his
bed all day today. seems to have a very bad cold

Stormy weather. lightning all around. no rain. plenty of wind E. W. and N.
Elias and James mensuales and costmen working working at corral
Mistolar. Coparate planting maize. Balbuena stopping cracks in
bebidó Jaquel Estancia. I went to Mistolar to see how shearing
was going on. J. Sanchez here at midday to borrow cart to
haul palms. Lirivarne left today. another dead yearling Pertó.
Barometer falling. very still and warm.

 also castrated another colt (Novillo) from the trapillo de
 los Muñitos.

A pleasant day & wind. **JUÉVES 30 THURSDAY** all of the Puesteras
 here for nations. Tomas with one cart went to Loma with parts
 mine etc to fence across the calchaguri. The other Peones got in
 the balance of the alfa. Coporate disking old chacra
 I sowed some Johnston grass. Elias went to Paso Calchaguri
 to see about shearing his sheep.

 Calchaqui. Sanchez parted with small troop. Butcherd stuff.

Elias went to Paso Calchaqui to deliver some of his novillos.

Coforate cutting alfalfa. Tomas and gente hauling. This evening
 Domingo and Balbuena helping. Tomas finished disking.

Began stacking hay but had to stop on account of rain. (finished cutting?)

 Sent correspondence into town. fixed up {estecedor} for hides
 and raised the first. Butehol cow B

Fine Snowing day. South wind. Making hay with all hands
 Chasque came back without correspondence.
 Mr. Benitz regulating accounts. Elias brought 60 colares
 from J. Maclero. Puerto.

Began raining about ten o'clock. fell 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ M. - raining in afternoon
 Finished stacking alfalfa and covered it with tiles
 Castrated one big bull at Estancia. Tambueas. -
 Received correspondence and two cans of Acorina
 Nothing doing in afternoon or at least very little
 Mended gate to chaera and set out a little bermuda grass

DOMINGO 7 SUNDAY

Weather cleared up nicely and was a warmish growing
 day with S and SE wind..
 Capataz and gente left for Lomo Poi to recoger potrero
 tomorrow.
 Jordan went to Calchaqui in afternoon..
 Nothing going on..

Warm muggy day, but in afternoon slight F
 wind. Had on rodeos of yeguas & cattle
 in south potrero. Castrated 3 potrillos, & sparted

 & castrated them in corral at Lomo Poi. Afterwards
 juntared the cattle at Lomo Poi & castrated 10 big padres
