Young goat for lunch & Jala, left 1.30 P.M. & arrived before 6 P.M. came by Santa Catalina 8 miles less going this way. Hot day.

Car, Rugby ran into us Folda Road no 414 only hit mud guard

14 MONDAY [45-320]

Warm day 31°, storm in afternoon but no rain.

Tennis tournament (ladies) all day here. Big party for lunch & about 40 for tea. Taking part: Katie & Bernice, Elsie & Mrs Norman, Ruth and Audrey, Isabel Roberts & Miss Stewart, Evelyn & Mrs Cassels, Agra & Kathleen C. Lorna & Miss Rizzo, Mrs Gelbie & M Crawford. Tie between Katie & Bernice and Mrs Isabel Roberts & Miss Stewart. Lots of swimming.

15 TUESDAY [46-319]

Warm day 27°. Knights did not arrive as expected. Joe Truitt & J. Middleton came in car from Cordoba arriving 3 P.M. -

Most of them went to Normans for tennis & night picnic.

Middleton & OB to call on Middletons &

Evelyn & Noreen out in Chevrolet. -

Sold 2 boxes of peaches El Tula to Juan Catalan for \$10.-

16 WEDNESDAY [47-318]

Hot day. The two girls went to picnic at brechi Corral with the Josefine people & Kennards. Mr & Mrs Bartie Knight arrived in afternoon train. I left by afternoon train to Bkires to see Antonio Patino's camp. OB to Mission school Kermesse.

Radiator at Vauxhall. Sold more fruit to Links Hotel.

Plaza Hotel 17 THURSDAY [48-317]

Arrived in Blairs at 9 AM. after a very dusty journey through Cordoba. Near Bl. had heavy rain yesterday afternoon. Immediately took Pearls to get restring at Mappin & Webb, various shopping & met Mr Paternoster & Higham at escribano Telleria & signed titles to the camp & paid with cheque on Bco Londres Blairs. Higham lunched with me at Plaza Hotel. In afternoon did not do much as the damp heat was too great. Met Frazers, also David Miles who just had an operation on his eye.

On train to L.R. 18 FRIDAY [49-316]

In morning went to Primaldi again re specs, saw Cuggia re Bankhall & gave him correspondence showing they still owe me £227.- for returning a/c. Also went to Bco Londres & gave cheque on Bco Nat. City for 60000. Also got giro to pay Fortnum & Mason £58-11/- @ 11.5% = 679.15. Got light coat etc at Smarts, also saw Luis Lacey. Had tea in afternoon with Mr J. Halahan, saw Eileen & Kathleen Halahan & Mrs Lockwood. Met Duncan Grant, Warden, etc at Hotel. Had dinner at Rito's station & left 9.45 P.M. train for L.R. Not quite so bad a day as yesterday.

20 SUNDAY [51-314]

Not quite so hot today. Willie & the piffords here for tea & work. - Mr Raymond here in morning for linen & Mr & Mrs Raymond for dinner. Obridge was 4.50. - Celesta & wife & dark girl for bathing in evening. -

Rainy day.

21 MONDAY [52-313]

Plu horses cleared out with their bridles suddenly from Corral No 5 & out of camp by west gate which was open. All horses found except a Colorado & terrible mare of Ratas manada.

Went over to La California after tea but Willie had left for Cordoba.

Had dinner & bridge at El Embu with Corde & Somers Smith.

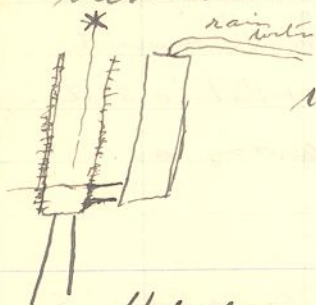
Cool night. - Now 6.⁵⁰

2nd Month

Hot day. 24 THURSDAY [55-310] El Rincon. -

Arrived in Cordoba at 6.³⁰ am. Went to escribano Ceralta & received from Renciman \$1153⁷ on ac. of Hipotecas, leaving a balance of \$15834.⁹⁷ to pay 29/7/27 to finish business off. - The hipotecas he paid today was \$1000. on 18 units Chico & \$153⁷.⁰¹ balance on lot 14. He also paid interests to 29/7/27 = 1866.²⁵. Martin the chauffer with Varnshall who left El Rincon 4 PM could not be found, until he turned up at 12.³⁰ so had lunch and siesta at Bristol hotel & left at 3.³⁰ and arrived in 2.⁴ hours. Everything well here. People stopping here: Jack Traill family & Miss Hutchinson. Bob Traill, S. Middleton, Mr & Mrs Bertie Knight, Evelyn Jones, Noreen Clark & Sykes. Mr & Mrs Barry & Willie were here in evening, also Johnnie & the Josefine lot. At night Noreen & Evelyn went to Cruz Chico dance. -

25 FRIDAY [56-309]

Rained 1 1/2 hrs this morning. - Cool afternoon.

Was down at Laleumbn & arranged with station master for tintitas wood piers at about \$20 two feet in Laleumbn. - Was also at Club. At night all went to La Cruz Grande dance. Played Bridge with Tragers & Jack Bell. lost \$5. - Mr Ibbison arrived in morning train to stay until after carnival.

Warm day 26 SATURDAY [57-308]

Carnaval begins today. Gathered almonds & fruit at El Tala with OB. Norman Jones arrived at noon from Blair. At night OB, J, Ibbison, Noreen Clark, & Evelyn Jones went to great ball at golf Club. Tremendous crowd there, guess 4 or 500. \$10. entrance. Lots of tennis today. Kennares were here, also Dr J. Halahan.

Bail here at night. Big crowd here, Very good time.

2 WEDNESDAY [61-304]

Ash Wednesday

Rained. 13th rain

Was at Jolly Club in afternoon with girls.

Mr Whitson left. Denton was here.

3 THURSDAY [62-303]

Brookers, Miss Miles were here. - also Dr Holahan.
