Wind changed to 15 TUESDAY [319-46] S & SE warm day.

Began making kitchen at lodge gate, & went to town to order stove \$95.- Willie, Eileen & Will Strong here in afternoon.

Also called Mr & Mrs Davis from Banderillas but OB & I were out in camp. (alfa slacking)

Getting very dry and am afraid harvest in No 6 & 11 will suffer. -

Very hot N & wind 16 WEDNESDAY [320-45] 36°

OB to Pisco morning train to dentist & return at night.

Willie was here in morning.

North wind very 17 THURSDAY [321-44] hot day. 39° . Dryness looks serious.
In camp in afternoon with O.B.

Another very 18 FRIDAY [322-43] hot day 39° with strong north wind.

Another very 19 SATURDAY [323-42] hot day with W wind 41° but in
evening began raining. Sykes turned up.

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NOVEMBER 1927

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Fine day. - 24 THURSDAY [328-37] On train to Ameghino.

Willie and I went to Tatato & bought a fine vicuña rug as wedding present for Tony Agar. \$325 (happ each). Afterwards went to Prots & Dwyer. At latter place looked at Helveticators. Liked one for hanging meat & he was ^{Wiener} (Swiss) cabling to U.S. for price etc it is 4 ft wide 5 ft depth 9 ft high 10% & cu ft capacity. Shipping weight 2550 lbs. Had tea with Higham along side of Britannia building. -
Left 7:30 for Ameghino on FCO.

Fine day. - 25 FRIDAY [329-36] Salali.

Arrived Ameghino about 4.40 when a Ford was awaiting us to take out to Salali 3 1/2 leagues. Found Mr Nelson & his son then took us out & showed us his pigs & dairies & separating plant. Milks about 2700 cans about 17000 lbs of milk now. Sows average 5.117 lbs per yr runt. Seems good alfalfa camp, but lots of thistles. Fine place, well installed, all good water, & very convenient.

Salali. Warm 26 SATURDAY [330-35] day North wind.

In morning Mr Nelson sent us, on his Ford car to La Maria. Brown place about 7 1/2 leagues off, where we spent the day. & Willie bought 8 bulls @ \$350 each, & one Pedigree at \$800 & 1 white one was given him as a present. Beautiful place with about 45 hectares of pasture & monte. Was treated very well there. Got back to Salali about 6.30 PM.

Warm day & wind 27 SUNDAY [331-34] On train to Resario. -
1 in Advent

Left with Mr Nelson for Bla. on train from Ameghino 7:30 & arrived in Bla 4.30 PM after a hot journey. Went to Club Infancia both & change & then to Motor Show & called on Tony Agar at the Boots house. Had dinner at Retiro Station & left for Resario on 10 PM train.

Hot day East wind 28 MONDAY [332-33] 32°

Arrived at Rosas 9.40. Mr & Mrs Bertie Knight stopping here. -

In afternoon went to see Raymond beginning to cut his wheat with his corki trilla. Doing quite good work..

cutting & stacking alfalfa in No 5 still.

Rained 6 mhm

29 TUESDAY [333-32] & still looks rainy & stormy.

Went to La California in afternoon with O.B. saw his crops & pigs. his Farnal cultivator doing about 1 1/3 hect per hour & sowing main 5 rows.

Martin & Mair go in car today to meet us in Cordoba Thursday morning.

Henry & I went to La California to receive the 5 bulls from Brown's place ^{"Le Marion"} we saw on 26/10. & bought them at \$350. and one white one given to Willie which he let me have at the average price.

Leave in morning train tomorrow for Rosario. - Price of maize this evening ^{7.62 in Rosario.}

Rained 5 mph

7 WEDNESDAY [341-24] last night -

Went to Rosario in morning to leave tonight for La Cumbre. -

OB & Moira came in evening to go also. Stopped the day at Palace Hotel. Went to Ingeniero in afternoon & saw Marshall, who told me he would take 7 car loads of 21 over 14th & he would fix the price. Wrote to Henry to send the best. Also told him to fix price for maize about middle of month. Lunched at Club & bet 6.50 at Bregu. Met E & S Paul, & OB and I go to dinner tonight at Cafa with Mr & Mrs Oliver Thomas.

31 Days

DECEMBER 1927

12th Month

Fine day.

8 THURSDAY [342-23]

Arrived in Cordoba 6.³⁰ A.M. & left in train 7.¹⁰ as Martin in big Vauxhall had broken 2 springs & steering arrangement, had to stop over in Cordoba.

Arrived in La Cumbre at 11 Am and young Martins drove us out.

Very little water in river and people complaining of want of water, but our garden looking fine. Walnuts seem quite sound.

In afternoon O.B. & I called on Doña Celara who is a bit ill but up sitting up. Seems that Aurora sold his house at the links for 36000 without furniture to Eng. Almos. His wife (Doña Maria) is still in sanatorium in Cordoba but getting better after her operation.

Fine day

9 FRIDAY [343-22] Warm 25°

Went this morning & to Golf Links and La Cumbre, took shot back from Raydon O.B.

Putting pump back to work at El Tala. Very little water in river.

Webster & Joe & Josie here in evening.

Martin telephoned from Cordoba saying he could not come until Monday. telephoned from Lloyd Davis. -

J. Halahan here this evening.

Hot day 28°

10 SATURDAY [344-21]

Was down at El Tala where they are fixing up pump. Well evidently has silt at bottom.
