Hamilton was away at Estancia Cia Termijo
in camion & we sent for him bringing
a bed. Had 111" rain on 9th & camp
& cattle looking well.

Very dry day E. wind. Went with Hamilton &
Sykes in camion to the post & called on Agola.
Said freight from Zupallar to Resistencia were
\$110 - both ways in dry time, otherwise 140. -
Cotton at Estancia gave about 2000 K hectaras
costs 10^{cts} K to gather. River not very high.
Had rained in 12 months to end of May 1970
at post. In afternoon motored to new well at
Sumbur's about 46 K. Stopped at Campo
Arroy. Saw Ward (in charge) & asked if he
knew if Camp for Sale & address of Mrs
Arroy. -

Went with Jimmys car Vermijo Co Estancia +
to Hardy's stage in Vermijo Co Estancia. Saw
Paton who is timber wright. Met Hardy as

5000 tons of timber there. In Lapacho they pay
76. tons to Estancia. Had lunch at Armistep
41 K. to Objir + back there. After tea Hamilton
took us in camion to Monte Rio Oro Heard
Monkeys. Getting ready to start back
to Resistencia.

Wednesday. Hotel Blanco Corrientes
Fine day fresh + chilly. Lykes + I left for
Resistencia 5.30 with Jimmys Rugby + as roads were
dry arrived in Resistencia 1 P.M. 7 1/2 hours.
176 K from C Winto. Wrote to Higham re Arway
Camp. would pay \$20. - back. Left for Corrientes 4.45
P.M. + was told steamer Iguazu for Posadas was
full tonight so have to sleep here tonight + decide
tomorrow what to do.

Forcast day. Telegraphed first thing to Posadas
to reserve beds to Iguazu on Arunta which leaves

Club where we met Ward, Miss Mendionda who
is head of club, also met Briand + others + had tea.
Quite a social gathering. Ward had dinner with
us + cocktails with King Park + Taylor. Took 10^{PM}
train for Posadas going by Monte Caseros + then up.
Ward seems very enterprising.

26

Friday. On train to Posadas. Rained all last
night + today. We arrived at Monte Caseros about
10 AM + left for Posadas 4 P.M. Had lunch at a hotel
+ took a Rio Uruguay. Sat in Taylors car until
we got to M Caseros. Neisum(?) was on train also an
old lady who was a Knight. + had dinner together.
Leaves very sudden with water. City is rather nice
country to look at. Seems a large English element is
P. - growing yerba + citrus.

Saturday '55 **JULIO** Rained last night

27

Nearly all night & some this morning & the rest was a fine day. Arrived at Posadas about 4 AM & went to Michener's office & then on board of Squeague. Sykes & I got a cabin & a Beron Scholentoy. Steamers full. American tourists Mr & Mrs Bradley, Miss Green, Miss Birch & Miss Bristol on board & on same table. Quite a good steamer & food not bad extra. Say river is 30 to 35 mt deep.

Squeague falls. Rained some in morning early on boat, but fine day. Reached Puerto Aguirre at 2 PM. & as we were about 80 passengers had trouble in getting to the falls, about 60 minutes. One of the cars had broken down & I was one of the last to leave Puerto Aguirre getting to Hotel Squeague at about 8 PM. Got room in annex, not so good as had to go across to get a bath or wash to the hotel. Great crowd here & in good spirits. -

29

Very muggy day looks like rain. Our party of 8 went in car about a league & then in a canoe to see the Parganta del Diablo, the biggest falls very fine. In afternoon walked with a big party to falls nearest here. Say about 80 guests here in hotel. Very crowded & our room in annex only has 2 beds & a chair.

Hotel Squeague falls 30 Tues day. -

Tamp muggy day & rained some. In morning at 9 AM went with big party on foot to see the falls from below. I think the San Martin falls. Very slippery & lots of climbing. In afternoon did not go out as it rained. Had some bridge. Cinema in hotel every evening. - Wrote post cards.

Wednesday. Cold overcast disagreeable day.
The party who were stopping here left for Puerto Aquirre
to catch the Comuna for Posadas including our
American friends Mr & Mrs Glen Bradley, Miss Green,
Miss Birch & Miss Bristow & Mr Nielsen. Lykes & I are
the only ones left except 4 people ^{who arrived today.} & we moved our
quarters to main hotel.

Had a walk in a picado called Barrera.
Wrote a memo letter to B.

AGOSTO

1

Thursday. Very cold last night & a beautiful
clear morning & overcast in afternoon.

In morning went with auto to the canoe opposite near
side of Garganta del Diablo & went across to the
Brazilian side where the hotel ruins are & saw
the falls. Much the best view but very slippery.

A german family are there. Got some black tobacco
there. In afternoon had a short walk.

Friday, Puerto Aquirre.

Left the Iquazu hotel in auto 9 am & arrived here at 10^{am}
18 K. The chocolate maker Saint, wife & lady came along as
they had a private steamer "Ciudad de Posadas". The steamer
'Duyango' did not arrive as expected (to take us to Men-
dez) / we have to stop the night, however this is quite a
good hotel, but we are losing time. Guess some thing
must have happened to steamer. Sent a wire-
less telegram to Henry to answer how things getting
along.

AGOSTO

Saturday

3

Left Puerto Aguirre. Beautiful day, but cold morning & very cold tonight. Guess will about freeze. Heard today by wire less that steamer 'Iguazú' had run against something had to return to Edoardo & that the Corumba was on way up here. Don't know when we will get to Mundy. Stopped about in morning and in afternoon crossed to Brazilian side in canoe, opposite but had to come back as hard walking in brush Tiger skin was offered to be brought at \$5.5.

Hotel Iguazu Puerto Aguirre.
Sunday. Another fine day but a cold night. Went at 9:30 in a row boat to Foz de Iguazu (Brazil) taking 2 hours as there were some rapids. Had quite a good lunch at International Hotel where we met Mr Wainwright Am. Vice Consul en way to Guayaquil via Olinda. We took a carmin & had a short drive to see a small yerba plantation. Came back here in 1 1/4 hours. Wainwright coming with us. Telegram from Henry saying cold & dry. S.S. 'Corumba' expected here tonight from Posadas.
(Did not come)

AGOSTO

Monday

5

Fine day, coldish night. S.S. Corumba arrived about 11 o'clock to leave Wednesday, 4 P.M. Boat about 40 passengers who left for the falls. Got papers from 25 to 30 July, which we borrowed. Not much doing today.

Hotel Iguazu P. Aguirre. Beautiful day. Lykes Wainwright & I went in a canoe & the butlers & 3 cadetes down the Parana to Puerto Jimenez where there is a beautiful plantation of all sorts of trees & fruits & yerba, a regular Park. We saw them picking yerba. We walked through the forest to Bertoni about 2 Kil. Fine walk, also a very interesting place. Got some yerba at Mrs Jimenez. Had our picnic lunch at her house & she was very kind & showed us about. Mrs Jimenez pays her 200 classes of citrus (Lykes says sh. said 400!) Took us 1 hour to come and 3 to come back. Well worth the trip (like a dream) on the Corumbes.

7

Ld. "Columb". Fine day warmer. -
Went on board after lunch & after tourists
(about 40) arrived from the falls, left 2 P.M.
We tied up at El Dorado for the night as
the Capt wants to be careful after the ac-
cident to the Itz'inggo last week. Seemed
to have been the Capt's sole fault.
Very nice on river & stopping at a great many
places for passengers etc.

Thursday, Palace Hotel, Posadero, Fine day
slight fog in river in morning but we left
right off & arrived here 5 P.M. Quite a
large Hotel. Had dinner with Wainwright
& then saw him off on train to Belén.
Went to cinema after words "Yo soy cule
pate."

Palace Hotel Posadero. Warm windy N wind ^{strong}
Got a car at 50.- to take us to the ruins at San
Ignacio taking 2 hrs. Ruins I guess about
25 hect. built by Jesuits. Had lunch at
Italian fonda there & met Mr & Mrs Clark
there. Came back in bus then I hrs & called
at station to get tickets to Asuncion but not
open. Went to experimental station where the
Professor showed us around. Very interesting.

Saturday, Gran Hotel Central Española, Villa Rica
Strong N wind. Warmest day had yet. -
Arose at 4 AM & got on train for Asuncion
& stopped over at Villa Rica getting here at 5:30 P.M.
About 30 I guess tourists here on train al-
so. Good deal of open country, with hard
grass & cattle very poor. Englishman on train
says good camps worth about \$2000 & larger (1600 hect.
Called on Julian Jengalez who took us to Club & met him at
Cinema at night. Lush & Vegetation. Country poor on
at war scare with Bolivia & 1.- Aug £18.70 Paraguay

AGOSTO

Sunday Hotel España American Asunción

1st day, guess about 11³⁰. This morning we got a car + took Don Jolani to a sugar factory close by, owned by a family of Hungarians. Quite interesting, but the cane does not seem so thick + long as at La Palma. They grind about 100 tons a day giving about 7% sugar. Had Paraguayan Ant tail at Jolani. Took 2:30 Pm train to Asunción arriving 8:30. Tried first to get in Hotel Oriental, no room. So came here. Not very good, but room + place seems crowded. Very pretty country about 2 hours from here. Nice girls with bright coloured dresses.

12

Monday Hotel España American Asunción. Very hot last night + mosquitos + bad to sleep. Today 35°. In morning got our tickets for Guaraní which sails Wednesday for Cesarito. Bot skins, + dried curios etc from Elco J. De Wit, + Cullac 350 also cigars from Otto Messinger who gave prices for cigars put at 10000. To see things Botanical gardens in afternoon. Looks very neglected. To cinema at night.

AGOSTO

13

Asunción Hotel España American

Very hot muggy day again. In morning bot some under clothes + at an English library got a card to Aviaison field where we went to see quite a good record, but did not go in as man in charge was not in, so we went to a small town let. Got a silver cup + plate for 1800 Paraguayan. In afternoon after some shopping called on Mrs + Miss Bird at the legation. In evening went to cinema "Battle of Creval" + Falkland Isles. Met Testafane the ace seed man.

On Board "Gearany" 14

Wednesday. Quite warm today. Quite moderate bill at Hotel. Went on board 7 am + left at 8. Restored by woman selling Manduty. Got a mate + bottle 100 Arg + Manduty 200. Paraguayan ear rings 18. Arg. My cabin 49 along side of wheel. Discovered the Equator went make combination + convenient. Shower who is controller of R.R. to Embocacion is on board. Constable got off at Formoso, has camp of his own + also manages Estancia. Giving us quite a lot of information. —
