Received from Santos Begonha. on ac. of the BLs sold to him.

Sent to Fortunato Roth. San Nicolas a check (\$142.80.94.67) for 6.238.8 for the cattle bought of him in Paganino.

Butchered a cow.

Vanilla and we can shoot. stopped shooting.

Cavello came back from running cattle in Begonia.

Big storm coming <sup>8 SATURDAY [282-84]</sup> up in the evening.

Look like real rain.

One of Begonias cows died in So. also one of Dickinsons. in So. S.

Butchered a cow.

Locusts. learned up this evening. but only a few.Rained hard <sup>9 SUNDAY [283-85]</sup> all day. beautiful day.

splendid weather.

Butchered a cow.

Sent to the station for a cow.

Mr. Fair and three cutters here.

Carted over meat from the station.

Herriman and poor putting 2 more miles ahead;  
No 567 and 8 potinos.

a cow BL died in No. 7. and a cow belonging  
to Robinson in No. 5.

Paid for No. 302 & 8 as soon riding cattle.

Cloudy day. wind storm in the afternoon had to stop shearing. Went finished the capon flock. brought up 162 flock from the Tiquia.

Cared for the rest of the men, and began to cut fire wood.

Patched a cow.

Sent all after wool, plus shears, and new or old ones to the Tiquia. Two cows dead, 1 D.D. in No. 7 and 1 Robinson in No. 5. One of the horses in Hamm's Tiquia, fell dead.

## 14 FRIDAY [288-78]

Fire Insurance Days of Grace expire

Rained a little during the night. but fine day. Began to shear flock No. 2 at 10 o'clock.

Catched the old sheep. separated all the lambs and caponitos.

Patched a cow, a cow in No. 5 died Robinson.

Subsisted here for the night.

Wrote and prepared went out during.

Rainy day. 15 SATURDAY [289-77] Cared wool over to the station galpon. finished cutting fire wood.

finished flock No. 2 put them into No. 6 pasture. began to shear No. 3 flock.

Morante took away 40 cows (sold to Sabatina) he paid me 600.00 Robinson paid me out of mazana 552.00 Patched a cow.

## 16 SUNDAY—18 aft Trin [290-76]

Fine day. Robinson took away 120 cows.

finished shearing No. 3 flock. began on No. 4.

Patched a cow and a sheep.

brought 2 cart loads of wool to the station.

Butchered a cow.

 4 bags wool got damp. Heavy rain all

Butchered vaguilla and calves. Sinala and lambs  
No 1 flock lost 265. counted whole flock 1180  
No 2 " (old) lambs 13 " " 450

Salvatierra pasted 48 cows. LN

Robinson and Gaitan stop the night to part tomorrow.  
Sent the 6 hengas to town.

Horses got out of pasture last night and colonist  
kicked them up. Cold weather and drizzling  
tonight. Mr Spangler br't Mrs Spangler and  
family and then went back to Rosario.

29 SATURDAY [303-63]

Butchered vaguilla. Sinala and 68 lambs in No 3  
flock and counted all 743. 1 sheep died no 3 flock  
Gaitan took 150 of Robinsons cattle.

Killed about 40 calves and skinned them today.  
Fine day. No rain last night to amount to  
anything. Cow of Robinsons died.

30 SUNDAY—20 aft Trin [304-62]

Butchered vaguilla. Herman playing cricket.  
Hot day. Jackson was here.

Weighed the 57 bengas of wool at station  
and marked them 11 bengas lana - 1493 kilos  
46 " sheep 5994.

Peones cutting out weeds and doing odd  
jobs. changed manadas into different pastores.  
Very hot day with strong north wind. Butchered  
at station and Newman was at Las Rosas to look  
at rodeo. Could not send wool to Bulrich, as  
Plaza Constitucion is blocked up with wagons.  
Capon died. Robinson fed 120 heads.

## 1 Nov TUESDAY [306-60]

All Saints'

Butchered vaguilla. Had a strong storm near-  
ly all night, and this morning early rained a  
little. Watt junior went to Vicente Soto. Peones  
hoeing out weeds in horse potero. Mrs. Spangler  
left as child is sick. Cold weather again.  
2 caponecitos ho, flock died.

## 2 WEDNESDAY [307-59]

Peones hoeing out more weeds. Parted & colt out  
from Hemmings' potero. Vicente Soto came & paid  
1000 dollars for cattle Morant bought, and parted  
out 35 cows. Slight frost. Sent telegram to  
see about vanillas. Hot day.

Butchered vaguilla.

Las Rosas gente parted out in different potreros (15 animals.)

Killing calves at Lijeras.

Herman & peones fixing fences and filling up around belidas.

Tropa of 500 novillos of Brandt & pertas locked in.  
cool day.

Dickson was here, says frost done damage to wheat in Canada Gomez.

Prieto arrived with Chaco tropa.

alfalfa, and filled up around belidas.

Hot day and look like rain.

Found 4 corderitos more dead No 1 flock.

1 cohudito died (freshly capared.)

Butchered vaguilla.

5 SATURDAY [310-56]

Gunpowder Plot

Had a heavy storm last night and rained a good deal. also some to day. Lightning killed 24 capones.

Josefine & family left for Buenos Ayres.

Butchered two capones. Sent 1 to Miss Angier.

Mig. Faire stops night.

6 SUNDAY - 21 aft Trin [311-55]

Paid the Chaco tropa peones off. Rained very  
good deal again last night. Miguel Faire left.

Salvatierra sent 32<sup>nd</sup> novillos to envarar.

Butchered vaguilla.

Chaco tropa peones, except one who is sick, left. Took along 11 discos mares at first, and 2 horses. Handed a capon for them. Peones working around from house, filling up, etc.

Wheat of the colonists beginning to look yellow on account of the frost on 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Herr of Big fortuna died. Marango manada fine day. Signed two payares sent by Lett for <sup>from</sup> <sup>Oct 22</sup> <sup>Adolfo</sup> <sup>Bustos</sup> Leonis' cattle - one for 6000 dollars for 3 months, and 1 for 4 months 5509      Butchered vaguilla

8 TUESDAY [313-53]

Dispatched the wool (57 bungas) to Adolfo Bustros to sell at public auction. Pd. guia for wool 8¢ per 10 kilos 45.50

Peones filling up around bebidas big potrero, etc. Warm day.

Butchered vaguilla. -

9 WEDNESDAY [314-52]  
Prince of Wales born, 1841. = Lord Mayor's Day

Moville Chaco had got out of Lijeras potrero. Herman, Manuel & capataz Lijeras campained them and found 45, some at Isaias Sebastian, Cieno Isabella, some at Chilcas. 5 or 6 are still missing. Old flock of sheep are also missing. Very hot day. Basilio Gaitan came tonight. - Peones filled up around bebidas at his jaguale 6 & 7 potreros.

Butchered vaguilla. -

Varijas came at last and cochins began hauling them

Had a tremendous rain towards morning till noon.  
 Cuello came with <sup>Juniin</sup> ~~troopa~~ at noon and looked in slack  
 potreros for a day or two. 13 days march from <sup>2 months</sup> Junin and  
 5 days giving thru. Very thin catch and just about get here.  
 Could not do anything today on account of wet. Basilio  
 Gaitan paid 2300 dollars for Robinson. Lightning struck  
 big ~~testado~~ cart horse. one that cleared so many times.

11 FRIDAY [316-50]  
 Martinmas. Scotch Quarter Day. Half  
 Quarter Day. 10<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> A.M.

Bernardi parted out 77 vaguillanas <sup>2<sup>nd</sup></sup> at Lijeras @ 15.79  
 and 1 calf at 11.07 and pd for them. Gaitan also  
~~parted~~ ~~paid~~ for 100 cows of Robinsons. Lent Letts commiss.  
 114.40 for buying cattle to Reho (Rosario) 3 pones being  
 varillas. Beautiful day. & cool. Killed calves.  
 Butchered vaguilla  
 Orina sent for fat capon (para guasa)

## 12 SATURDAY [317-49]

Cuello took all hands and some *convidades*, and took the  
 Junin cattle out of slack potreros down to Lijeras to 3 potreros  
 and then parted the 15-2 yr olds into 2 potros - 518 cows  
 horses and 460 small animals. Soto paid 1000. or  
~~10~~ reales in parts tomorrow. Butchered vaguilla and  
 bulls butchered one for the grub. Looks like rain. A fine splendid

## 13 SUNDAY—22 aft Trin [318-48]

Soto (Morante) parted 37 cows W. Butchered vaguilla.  
 Cochero left on a paseo to Rosario. —

Hernan took the peones to work on fence again.  
 Salatierra sold 50 of his encomienda novillado,  
 and parted 128 cows LN. and Leguizamón also  
 parted 12 cows LN. It was thundering this morning  
 and an awful hot day. Old sebruno & died from  
 heat (Isidro rode him). Jose Martínez began work again  
 after had been away for 8 days.  
 Butchered vaguilla.

## 15 TUESDAY [320-46]

Nash parted out 70 novillitos from south pastero for  
<sup>sold at 75.00</sup> Buenos Aires. Sent to Las Tomas for stray sheep  
 found 4. - Brought some milk cows from pastero.  
 It was a hot day. looks rainy..  
 Butchered vaguilla

## 16 WEDNESDAY [321-45]

Nash parted out 129 novillitos from south pastero  
 and sent them off on train. He paid 5000 or  
 6000 Ch. quins.

Working at fence

Boring varillas.

Man began sowing maize tijeras scattered, finished  
 sowing alfa north end.

Looks rainy, hot afternoon.

Butchered vaguilla.

Turner fixing water spout on roof.

3 barre gas died.

the corral and tools.

Butchered a cow. Troja of horses about in.

## 20 SUNDAY - 23 aft Trin [325-41]

Rained hard last night.

Paid off all the farm fees - also the  
two remittances Remmert and Calisto.

Alfred came back.

Butchered a cow.

Cloudy sultry weather.

Charred Leguia's cattle from 10% up to big mams-potem. put up a new stable in big mams-potem.

Nash sent 229 cows and 8 calves to minister. cows at 150.00 and calves at 75 cents per month. to be left until April. put them into M. Leguia took away 4 cows IV and 8 cows D.L.

22 TUESDAY [327-39]

Rained a little during the night. but a fine day.

Salvadora took away 91 cows IV.

nine man ploughing, harrowing, rolling and sowing alfalfa at the farm. mostly soon alfalfa coming up fine.

Butchered a cow.

23 WEDNESDAY [328-38]

Beautiful day. Filled the ship slip with water and Haynes' part slip.

Sent horse cart to station for sheep with alfalfa seed and rock salt.

Received a thousand rats from Abante on ac. of cattle.

Butchered a cow.

Loucks hatching out.

Received ac. of wool Bullock sold at market. Total cash \$365.9.

Very hot clear day.

Dipped the cotton flock 920, lost one and one died. Dipped the Sonora flock 572.

Morante took away 47 calves.

Paid Piguit Laramorene 4000, \$ also paid hotel and saddles bills.

Nash sent 198 novillas to Ensenada.

## 25 FRIDAY [330-36]

Dipped No 1 flock 1080 No 2 flock 492 counted and No 3 flock counted 754. - finished just before big storm and rain came on. Nash sent 310 cows with 1/2 calves to Ensenada.

Johnie went to Tyrant to see some cattle.

## 26 SATURDAY [331-35]

Had a tremendous rain last night and fine cool day. Fixed Pilars water drawing machine which had fallen into well. Sent to Las Lomas for 6 shps.

## 27 SUNDAY—1 in Advent [332-34]

10° 28° A.M.

Beautiful cool day. Johnie came back. Mr. Nash and Toddell came with him.

Took all hands and cut totos of the punin cattle. Johnnie went to Rosario to tratar for Pezano cattle. Donkin came. Hauled bricks to Pilar's priest to brocal well. Fine day. We Butchered a cow.

## 29 TUESDAY [334-32]

It was a warm day north wind. Took all hand and cut totos of the punin cattle and got finished. Alfred went away up to the Charco to day. Todd went off on Rosario. Mr. Donkin took all his things away. German drove Alfred over to station sent cart for the load of taro and got a dimension of cana Stark sent 15 bush

Mr. Ripley was here and left some horses here he also left a pack.

## 30 WEDNESDAY [335-31]

St. Andrew, Ap.

It was a very hot day with a west wind. German burnt all the old stalks of alfalfa. We butchered a cow. We sent cart up to gate with duckie and geer. In afternoon German reconditioned all the station. The carpenter split a new bucket in number seven potrero and also mended the bucket over big potrero. Jose and Tomo split wood into Pilar potrero. Benito mended fence all day. Rincon helped carpenter.

In the fine day it was very hot.

Rimjo and Roque rained wood, and levies mended fence. Herman went down to the Tijuar. The men got finished plowing. In afternoon carpenter mended the char. In big potrero, Mother and Marjory went over to the town in big carriage. Don Galdan's men came to take a trocha of Mr Robinson's cattle.

## 2 FRIDAY [337-29]

This morning it was very warm we intragaged 120 cows of Mr Robinson. And we received two thousand two hundred dollars for Mr Robinson.

We butchered a cow.

In afternoon Mr Stark and two butchers came to see him novillo.

We put all the slaves in the back yard. And we cut the spars at raining wood. We had all the sides out.

## 3 SATURDAY [338-28]

Was a warm lady day with a strong north wind. We butchered a cow. Herman went all over camp carpenter and Roque went to the Tijuar and mended fence. In afternoon Stark sent a trocha of cows 134 small. Stark also sent 81 men we put them down at the Tijuar innumerable where.

## 4 SUNDAY—2 in Advent [339-27]

O 2<sup>o</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> A.M.

Was a fine warm day. Herman and Pedro drove over to the station to meet the train. Mr Robinson came to get his money. We sent him a horse to go over to the Tijuar. Carpenter every day to town to bring horse back. It rained a little yesterday afternoon.

It was a fine day it was very warm. Herman went alone camp. Carpenter made a bucket.

We spent forenoon at arranging the quirtale of mire. Carter Rura took 15 cows.

We butchered a cow. Johnnie came back home to day from looking at cattle. Herman and Roque mixed cana and cleaned out the store room.

In afternoon, Qualls and Chiquina were here. A sheep died in big pasture.

## 6 TUESDAY [341-25]

Rec'd from Morante on ac. of cattle \$500. Colours cutting wheat.

Morante painted cows from No 2 with stick paint. one of the times from Nicolas broke his leg. have them him.

Roller got sick at the time nearly finished work. Caught it up in the cut.

His home and two children came on a visit.

Baethings were all here in the evening.

Paid off all the plan power.

Doña had her eye put out by a piece of iron in the blacksmith. a day of accidents.

## 7 WEDNESDAY [342-24]

Felt day first for hunting. rather dry. Maynes cousin Willie come up from P. R.

Ladies went out dining.

Sold out a moccasin. but miles to colors. changed 3 cattle from No 7 into No 5. and No 4 into No 5. Caught some animals out of Dickinson's camp.

Morante took away 30 cows IV

Chiquina took away 60 animals (BL)

brought up the chestnut stallion - horse

Fine day. Looked like rain during the night.  
Salvadora took away 70. of his mohillas.

Miguel Bernade took away 30 reales silver paid for  
them 330.00

Brought up the cattle from the pican sent them  
to a colostrum to eat what.

Turned hoop and hair of human bones.  
two of Master animals died 100 pesos.

## 9 FRIDAY [344-23]

It rained a little in the morning. And a strong north  
wind got up it was cloudy. Johnie went away  
to look at some cattle. Herman washed his saddle  
the carpenter worked at Johnie's cobboard.

Fernanteryo turned the hedge around front  
garden. every thing is all right.

10 SATURDAY [345-21]  
Black Game and Grouse Shooting ends

It was a cold clear morning. We dipped the capons.  
In afternoon. Mr Johnie drove her team over  
to the station and brought home a box of Ostrich.  
We butchered a cow. Pigman girl came to  
tell us that the well rope broke.  
Fernanteryo is sweeping the back yard and front  
It got cloudy in the evening.

11 SUNDAY—3 in Advent [346-20]  
Ember Week. C<sup>2</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> A.M.

This morning it was a fine day.
