Sorego Lamb: Punta de lanza de otras de la

Sonuga lambis oreja izquierda. la otra entera  
Punta de lanza de atrás de la  
oreja derecha. y muesca de adelante  
de la oreja izquierda.

The punta de lanza on the bocas is the señal, and the muescas; (cut out with a machine) is to tell the year the lambs were signaled, changing position or number of muescas every year. During 1896 the muesca was on the back of the ear, cayon (or male) lambs. only have the punta de lanza.
